ABSTRACT

Redesign is a plan for making changes to the structure and functions of a object, a building or a system so as to better serve the purpose of the original design, or to serve purposes different from those set forth in the original design. Interior design planning case study is Interior Re-design of Mother and Child Hospital Hermina Pasteur Bandung. Problems were found in RSIA Hermina Pasteur issues related to comfort patients and hospital visitors like conditions are unfavorable due to less than the maximum in the processing of the interior of the hospital. Hospital corridor is narrow, non-medical facilities are inadequate, less ergonomic furniture designs, as well as the handrail hospitals do not function optimally in terms of security. Design methods used include data collection either directly or indirectly. Survey, documentation, interviews and direct observation to the field to find out what issues are contained in RSIA Hermina Pasteur Bandung and its relation to the existing hospital standards in particular to the interior design. The redesign goal is to improve the quality of hospital services while applying the standards existing hospital. Expected results of the Interior Re-design RSIA Hermina Pasteur Bandung is creating new designs with the theme " Healthy Care Mom and Kids Center " and the concept of space "Homey" can answer the problems of design contained in this hospital.
