ABSTRACT

Stock prices are very important for the company because the stock price is one of the company's performance indicators. Stocks that have a high price are usually the stock of a company that has a good corporate performance. And companies that have good performance, will be more profitable for investors.

The purpose of this research is to know the influence of Board of Directors, Independent Commissioner, Return On Assets (ROA) and Current Ratio (CR) to stock price of food and beverage manufacturing company in 2012 to 2016 period either partially or simultaneously. This study uses secondary data that is data derived from financial statements and annual reports published by BEI.

Population in this research is manufacturing company of food and beverage sub-sector period 2012 until 2016. Sampling technique used in this research is purposive sampling and obtained by 14 food and beverage company period 2012 until 2016. The method of analysis used in this research is data regression analysis panel and processed data are used with Eviews 10.

The results showed that simultaneously the Board of Directors, Independent Commissioner, Return On Assets (ROA), and Current Ratio (CR) have a significant influence on stock prices. While partially the Board of Directors as measured by the number of the Board of Directors does not affect the stock price. Independent Commissioners as measured by the Proportion of Independent Board of Commissioners have a negative influence on stock prices. Profitability as measured by Return On Assets (ROA) has a positive influence on stock prices. Liquidity measured by Current Ratio (CR) has no effect on stock prices.

Suggestions based on the results of this study, then for companies that want to increase the company's stock price, then the company can increase the value of ROA by raising the company's profit. And for investors are suggested in taking the decision to invest shares in food and beverage companies, can pay attention to company performance
