ABSTRACT

Street children is one of the real social problems faced by every major cities in Indonesia. According to the data of the Social Service in the year 2018, the number of street children in the city of Bandung as much as 1,986 people. Addressing the problem of street children is our common obligation as a social community. After conducting a survey, in Bandung, there are child protection (RPA) who serves as the giver of the education and social service providers. However, after survey, there is a problem on the RPA i.e. the limitation of facilities so that it is not able to accommodate events and users. This theme will depict a design of space as a means of education that its design directly studying the characteristics of street children so that learning spaces would be created for them.
