Which after that can be used using Interior Response Flexibility which is a pillar in determining the design concept. Therefore, it is necessary to familiarize with learning about the aspects of danger in school through the concept of "Learning Responsive Earthquake Responses" through design concepts that can help children by using flexible and responding forms. In addition, the application system is easy for children to remember when an earthquake occurs, making children and other users better understand sensory how to protect and evacuate when an earthquake occurs at school. Therefore, environmental support in the interior such as a space that educates the "Educational Safety Room" in supporting the success of the concept.
