Abstract: Subak is an irrigation system which is used mainly for water management on paddy fields based on the Tri Hita Karana Philosophy. United Nation Education, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) on 12th June 2012 has designated subak as World Heritage in the Cultural Landscapes category. The official name given by the UNESCO is "Cultural Landscape of Bali Province: the Subak System as a Manifestation of the Tri Hita Karana Philosophy". However the Balinese People in general often imagine or interpret subak with these following pictures, a vast and bordered paddy fields compound, rice farmers working together in the field of irrigation, and the physical or irrigation systems itself as telabah (waterway), empelan (waterdam on the river), tembuku (facility to direct the watercourse) and other facilities.
