

GLOSSARY

Formal Sector	: Business form that already have a legal basis, have a fixed place of business, employees who have quite a lot, and has a large capital.
Informal Sector	: Business form founded with capital relatively small, irregular business hours, does not rely on formal education, and generally do not have a business license.
Payback Period	: Method of determining how long an investment will return.
Internal Rate Of Return	: The method search for a interest rates that make present value of cash inflow or proceeds be the same worth outflow or investment.
Net Present Value	: The difference between the present value of cash inflow or proceeds with expenditure need for investment or capital outlays .
Demand	: The amount of goods and services to be purchased in a variety price levels at any given moment.
Retained Earnings	: Post the balance that is indicative of the total profit not be distributed as dividen. This profit will be invested again in a company.
Cash Flow Statement	: Report that provides information about cash inflow and cash outflow in a period of reporting.
Income Statement	: A systematic report about income, cost, loss, or profit obtained during a given period.
Balance Sheet	: Systematic report about assets, liabilities, and capital or equity.
