## **ABSTRACT**

As for the background of this design is the racial Behavior in Indonesia between ethnic Chinese with other ethnic still very contrast to this day. The successor generation still has the inherent stereotypes and negative perceptions of each ethnicity, which in fact is a legacy of the Colonial era that is Devide et Empera which is still inherent with Indonesian thought, namely the mention of indigenous and nonnative. In Bandung had happened separation of trading space and settlement of Chinese citizens by the Dutch East Indies government as a social separator.

The design of this comic concept about the mixing of Chinese and Sundanese in Bandung in the past, illustrating the harmony of indigenous people (ethnic Sundanese) and immigrants (ethnic Chinese) at that time, although the Dutch East Indies government attempted to make Devide et Empera gap to discriminate socially and weaken unity.
