The availability of blood for donors according to the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Indonesia is ideally 2 % of the total population adjusted to international health standards (WHO). So, if the population in Indonesia amounted to 258.705.00 people, then ideally needed as many blood 5.174.100 blood bags. However, in the year 2016, the amount of blood collected from donors as much as 4.600.00 bags of blood so there is a lack of blood needs of 574.100 blood bags.
