In Indonesia, there is a wide variety of traditional foods from each province in the archipelago. Indonesia holds an important role in building diverse cultures in Indonesia. Traditional food that is diverse from each province, has a distinctive taste, because it is equipped with herbs from spices. Cultural and culinary diversity is Indonesia's wealth to be proud of.
