ABSTRACT

Students that are in late adolescent age towards early adulthood. This condition

is a period to achieve a more mature relationship with the opposite sex or also called

dating, dating is an activity between two people to get to know each other better by living

together. Dating violence is the discovery of patterns of behavior that are unpleasant,

abusive and used to exert power and control over the couple. The purpose of this study

was to find out how the dating violence victim in Bandung attitude's changed. This

research was conducted with qualitative research methods and using the phenomenology

paradigm. In obtaining credible data researchers conducted interviews with four

informants from three different universities. The results of the study are (1) The most

common form of violence is the limitation of activity, all informants explained that the

violence starts from the limitation of activities due to excessive jealousy of the informant's

friendship environment. (2) The attitude alteration felt by some informants includes the

fear of starting a relationship with the opposite sex and feeling difficult to believe in the

opposite sex.
