Wayang Golek is a form of performance art that grows and develops in the West Java region, spreading from Cirebon in the east to Banten. Therefore, the purpose of the design of the Wayang Golek Museum is to conserve and introduce Sundanese wayang puppets to the people of Bandung and surrounding areas and to create the Sunda Wayang Golek Museum in the city of Bandung which provides facilities that are interactive, innovative, imaginative and educational to conservation that can enhance public awareness about conservation to information about the development of Wayang Golek innovation and by visiting museum visitors can increase their love for wayang golek.
