Patient's mental condition is very influential on all activities he undertakes. Likewise, people who are sick, a stable mental condition and a calm feeling can help the patient's healing process. Based on data from the Indonesian Demographic and Health Survey (IDHS) in 2012, the maternal mortality rate (MMR) increased by 359 per 100,000 live births. In addition to the high MMR, according to the World Health Organization (WHO) in developing countries, 10-15%. While in Indonesia there were 22.4% of mothers experiencing depression after giving birth (postpartum depression). if this condition left, it will have a negative impact on the physical and psychological health of the mother and the baby being born. Therefore this design will make the interior design of a Women's and Children's Hospital located in the Bihbul Puskesmas field become a hospital that provides health services for women, pregnant women and children that are in accordance with the PERMENKES standard by using the Healing Environment approach and biophilic themes to provide a sense of serenity and comfort for maternal patients both before or after childbirth, and also change the image of a scary hospital for children. This can help the patient's healing process.
