

LIST OF TERMINOLOGY

Warehouse:	A place to store goods in specific number and time span.
Logistics:	Logistics is the art and science, goods, energy, information, and other resources, such as products, services, and people, from sources of production to markets with the aim of optimizing the use of capital.
Net Present Value:	Difference between expenditure and income that has been discounted using the social opportunity cost of capital as a discount factor, or in other words is the estimated future cash flow discounted at the moment.
Internal Rate of Return:	Indicator of the level of efficiency of an investment
Payback Period:	A certain period of time which determines the occurrence of a cash in flow which is cumulatively equal to the amount of investment in the form of present value.
