ABSTRACK

Sexual violence among adolescent girls is a big problem around the world. Sukabumi Regency has data on a high increase in cases of sexual violence. With so many cases of sexual violence in Sukabumi, the General Chairperson of the National Commission for Child Protection categorizes Sukabumi as an emergency red zone for sexual violence. Therefore, it takes the role of parental communication as the first guide in the lives of adolescents to prevent acts of sexual violence. The purpose of this study was to find out how the role of parentadolescent communication in preventing sexual violence. The method used in this study is a qualitative research method. The data collection technique used the interview and observation process. While the data analysis technique in this study was carried out by data reduction, data presentation and conclusion drawing assisted by thematic analysis using ATLAS.t software version 8. The results of this study indicate the role of parental communication in terms of conversation orientation aspects in the form of delivering educational messages sex, a form of caring and participation that parents provide. As well as the role of conformity orientation in the form of value application, applied rules and conflict resolution. In addition, there are new findings of a causal relationship between conversational orientation and conformity, namely the existence of adolescent emotional reactions marked by adolescent attitudes marked by awkwardness and shame. Research implications are discussed.
