## ABSTRACT

Work is something that must be done by an individual to meet his daily needs. In order to achieve a work-life balance, it is important to choose a job that matches the personality of an individual. Personality psychology is a sub-field of psychology that studies human traits and behavior in everyday life. Research shows that individual personality traits are related to the field of work in which they are performed.

In this study, the authors want to create a system that can help job seekers get a job that matches their personality. The personality factors used are the Big Five, namely Extraversion, Agreeableness, Conscientiousness, Emotional Stability, and Intellect. This personality factor is mapped using C4.5 to get a job that matches your personality. The work fields based on the 20 Job Families are taken from the O \* NET database.

The job recommendation system based on the Big Five personality has an accuracy value of 100% and an alpha test result value of 100%. The C4.5 method used in mapping the Big Five personalities has an accuracy of 99.99%. So it can be concluded that the system that is made runs according to its purpose, namely implementing the Big Five personality factors to determine job recommendations.
