Through this, it turns out that baduy tribal people can be nil from the Covid-19 virus for 15 months. Therefore, the film will have the title "When Baduy Talks Covid". This filmmaking uses Intercultural Communication Theory, Persuasive Communication, Culture, Local Wisdom, Film, Editing, Lighting, Sounding, and Cinematography as its supporting. The author will conduct an interview method in conducting data and fact initiators for this documentary. After that the author will process the data to be used as a documentary film that lasts 15 minutes using Full HD resolution 1920x1080 and 30 frames per second.
