

ABSTRACT

The formation of children's character is a long process and is the responsibility of parents. However, this will be different for children who live in a child welfare institution. These duties and responsibilities are replaced by the caretakers of the orphanage who will guide and assist the foster children in their daily activities. Likewise with the formation of the character of the foster children. The character building carried out by the caregivers is based on the vision and mission that has been created by the caretakers of the orphanage and becomes a reference for all program activities held in educating foster children. This also needs to be supported by the availability of facilities and space adjustments that support the vision and mission of the orphanage.

The purpose of the interior redesign of the Candra Naya Orphanage is to create a place to live that can help the process of forming the character of the foster children according to the vision and mission that is supported by a more cheerful and pleasant room atmosphere. The design method used is to obtain primary data by conducting interviews with the head of the orphanage dormitory, direct observation at the Candra Naya Orphanage building, documentation of the rooms and activities of foster children, and conducting questionnaires with foster children, while for secondary data conducted by studying literature on several books, journals, and articles. What is to be done in this redesign is to complete the supporting facilities for activities that are not yet owned, as well as to create a warm, comfortable, and safe room atmosphere according to the expectations of the orphanage management through a Character Building approach.
