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People with mental disorders or so-called ODGJ are people who experience mental disorders, the symptoms are due to stress and excessive hallucinations. Mental disorders can affect the function of psychology, behavior and life in society. People still think that ODGJ is scary and must be avoided, this is one of the reasons that causes their condition to worsen because they are intimidated and do not get support from the closest people.
