REDESIGN INTERIOR RECTORATE OF MUHAMMADIYAH BANGKA BELITUNG UNIVERSITY

The rectorate building has the main function as the office of the Chancellor and his staff to carry out their duties and authorities, but at the rectorate of the University of Muhammadiyah Bangka Belitung, besides functioning as the leadership office, it also functions as a place for lecturers and students to carry out activities. Currently the condition of the layout of the space at the rectorate of the University of Muhammadiyah Bangka Belitung is still not effective related to structural and interrelated activities, such as the LPPM room and LSPIK room which are still far apart from the rectorate building, on the 1st floor there is still a Study Program room where the 1st floor is a work area Chancellor and his staff. In addition, the Rectorate Building is also considered as the heart of a university that can bring out the characteristics of the university itself, but currently the rectorate of the Muhammadiyah University of Bangka Belitung does not bring out its characteristics through Interior Design.

For this reason, it is necessary to redesign Rectorate of Muhammadiyah Bangka Belitung University with the main aim of increasing work effectiveness through the arrangement of interconnected spaces related to similar activities, then bringing up the characteristics of the Muhammadiyah University through interior design, as well as to realize the closest achievements in terms of increasing the Accreditation and Vision of Muhammadiyah Bangka Belitung University, namely "To become a progressive and competitive university at the international level in 2034".
