ABSTRACT

This research aims to determine the coverage of the Ukraine-Russia conflict on CNN Indonesia's Online Media before the armed conflict began, to determine the coverage of the Ukraine-Russia conflict on CNN Indonesia's Online Media after the armed conflict began, and to identify differences in the coverage of the Ukraine-Russia conflict on CNN Indonesia's Online Media in the time period before and after the armed conflict began. This research uses quantitative content analysis research method. The research sampling was conducted by using non-probability sampling with purposive sampling type using 64 articles from the news coverage of the Ukraine-Russia conflict on CNN Indonesia's online media. The data analysis techniques used were content analysis of message differences based on the time period before the armed conflict began and after the armed conflict began. The results showed that there were differences in the coverage of the Ukraine-Russia conflict on CNN Indonesia online media in the time period before and after the armed conflict began. Which is evidenced by the increase in the frequency of interpretative reporting and the presence of journalistic actors in the news and with the largest decrease in the frequency of reporting using aggressive language and reporting criticizing the appearance of political figures in the Ukraine-Russia conflict.
