ABSTRACT

An orphanage is one of the institutions responsible for providing social welfare services to neglected children. However, in practice, irregularities often occur which cause the child to become stressed. When under stress, a person is able to survive if the surrounding environment is supportive, namely a comfortable and safe environment. The Putri Bala Safety Orphanage Foundation, as an object in the design, is an orphanage with conditions that are in a class A heritage building, the implementation of which still has several shortcomings in the form of room conditions that have not been used optimally, furniture has not been functioned according to user activity, and facilities are not yet available to accommodate soft skill and hard skill development activities for orphans. Based on the analysis of these problems, it is necessary to redesign the orphanage with a behavior approach by considering the redesign limitations on heritage buildings so that they are able to meet the needs of user activities based on their daily habits. Therefore, data was collected using a descriptive method which was processed with reference to related literature so as to produce an orphanage design that could accommodate the activities and needs of users in accordance with the goals of the orphanage listed in the vision and mission of the orphanage, so as to create orphanages with character, integrity which is able to prepare orphans to be able to contribute in social life with a larger scope.
