ABSTRACT

Currently, a lot of rehabilitation homes have been built in Indonesia, especially those in the West Java region, one of which is in the city of Bandung. A rehabilitation platform for NAPZA users in the town of Bandung is either the Rose Shrink Foundation which is directly under the shadow of the government or even a community of organizations (non-governmental) moving in the same field can be a place for those addicted to drugs. The Rose Shrink Foundation has a purpose to move in the field of overcoming the problem of using NAPZA (Narkotika, Psikotropika, dan Zat Adiktif others). This study aims to find out how the patient's openness by NAPZA is applied to the Rose Shrink Foundation. Self-openness according to DeVito is a form of communication of a person who conveys information about himself. This research uses qualitative methods. The technician takes data by looking at four sources, including a key source, a pasien patient, and an expert source, the counselor, who has theories in his field and as a therapist. The results of this study show that of the five dimensions applied in this study according to DeVito namely, Quantity, Assessment of Self-attraction, Accuracy, Extent of Self Disclosure, and Familiarity. Of these five dimensions, there are three of the most visible dimensions of the Foundation of the Roses: the Extent of Self-Disclosure, Accuracy, and Familiarity.
