INTERIOR REDESIGN OF SARININGSIH HOSPITAL WITH HEALING ACTIVITY APPROACH

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According to Law Chapter 1 Article 1 Number 44 of 2009, a hospital is a health facility that provides complete individual health services, including inpatient, outpatient and emergency care. Sariningsih Hospital is a Type D Military Health Agency located in Bandung which has the main task of providing support and health services to TNI soldiers, civil servants and their families, as well as providing health services to the general public. According to the Sariningsih hospital, some of the results of renovations at the hospital have not fulfilled the feasibility aspect, because there are problems in the interior aspects. Interior redesign planning at Sariningsih Hospital in general aims to make the existing space function optimally and specifically aims to improve some materials that do not meet standards, complete security aspects at the hospital, complete information aspects such as signage and arrange circulation of spaces which has a relationship when operating, so as to create an effective circulation of activities and prevent interruptions during activities in the hospital. In the interior design of Sariningsih Hospital with an Activity Approach, the data collection stage was carried out through several data collection methods, namely direct and indirect data collection. Collecting data directly can be done by means of comparative studies and interviews with key sources. While collecting data indirectly, namely by collecting data from various literature such as books, scientific journals and the internet.
