ABSTRACT

The city of Surakarta has many urban heritages that are relied upon as regional identity,

one of which is the Sangga Buwana Stage Tower. The Sangga Buwana Stage is a cultural

heritage building in the form of a tower located in the Kedhaton Keraton Kasunanan Surakarta

complex. The existence of ancient buildings such as Panggung Sangga Buwana has historical

value, aesthetics and scarcity which exclusively characterizes the culture of a city. Even though

it is considered an iconic building, the current development of the Keraton Kasunanan

Surakarta Area, both in terms of land use and buildings, pays little attention to the existence of

the area as a historical area. Communities around the palace tend to underappreciate the palace

area as a historical area, some elements have several times committed acts of vandalism on the

outside of the palace walls, and some even committed theft by breaking into the palace

building.

Ignorance of history and the symbolic meaning of the decoration of the palace buildings causes

these things to happen. Keraton conservation activities must be fully supported by the Surakarta

City Government and the people who are directly involved. For this reason, visual promotion

is needed which can educate the public about the history and symbolic meaning of the palace

decorations. Therefore, a specially designed typeface is needed to support promotion by

processing visual forms and symbolic meanings from the Sangga Buwana Stage into typefaces.

With this approach, it will be easier to introduce historical values and increase the existence of

the Surakarta Kasunanan Palace.
