As the founding member of SCF, the first International Conference on Web Services (ICWS) was held in June 2003 in Las Vegas, USA. The First International Conference on Web Services - Europe 2003 (ICWS-Europe'03) was held in Germany in October 2003. ICWS-Europe'03 was an extended event of the 2003 International Conference on Web Services (ICWS 2003) in Europe. In 2004 ICWS-Europe changed to the European Conference on Web Services (ECOWS), which was held in Erfurt, Germany.

SCF 2019 was held successfully during June 25–30, 2019 in San Diego, USA. Affected by COVID-19, SCF 2020 was held online successfully during September 18–20, 2020, and SCF 2021 was held virtually during December 10–14, 2021.

Celebrating its 20-year birthday, the 2022 Services Conference Federation (SCF 2022, www.icws.org) was a hybrid conference with a physical onsite in Honolulu, Hawaii, USA, satellite sessions in Shenzhen, Guangdong, China, and also online sessions for those who could not attend onsite. All virtual conference presentations were given via prerecorded videos in December 10–14, 2022 through the BigMarker Video Broadcasting Platform: https://www.bigmarker.com/series/services-conference-federati/series_summit.

Just like SCF 2022, SCF 2023 will most likely be a hybrid conference with physical onsite and virtual sessions online, it will be held in September 2023.

To present a new format and to improve the impact of the conference, we are also planning an Automatic Webinar which will be presented by experts in various fields. All the invited talks will be given via prerecorded videos and will be broadcast in a live-like format recursively by two session channels during the conference period. Each invited talk will be converted into an on-demand webinar right after the conference.

In the past 19 years, the ICWS community has expanded from Web engineering innovations to scientific research for the whole services industry. Service delivery platforms have been expanded to mobile platforms, the Internet of Things, cloud computing, and edge computing. The services ecosystem has been enabled gradually, with value added and intelligence embedded through enabling technologies such as Big Data, artificial intelligence, and cognitive computing. In the coming years, all transactions involving multiple parties will be transformed to blockchain.

Based on technology trends and best practices in the field, the Services Conference Federation (SCF) will continue to serve as a forum for all services-related conferences. SCF 2022 defined the future of the new ABCDE (AI, Blockchain, Cloud, Big Data & IOT). We are very proud to announce that SCF 2023's 10 colocated theme topic conferences will all center around “services”, while each will focus on exploring different themes (Web-based services, cloud-based services, Big Data-based services, services innovation lifecycles, AI-driven ubiquitous services, blockchain-driven trust service ecosystems, Metaverse services and applications, and emerging service-oriented technologies).

The 10 colocated SCF 2023 conferences will be sponsored by the Services Society, the world-leading not-for-profit organization dedicated to serving more than 30,000

services computing researchers and practitioners worldwide. A bigger platform means bigger opportunities for all volunteers, authors, and participants. Opportunities and Challenges in Metaverse the Rise of Digital Universe

Abstract. The concept of the metaverse dates to 1992; however, the popularity of this concept has gained increased attention in 2021 following the announcement by Mark Zuckerberg. The topic of the metaverse is a new and attractive topic that is gaining increased insight from researchers. The paper focuses on a broader evaluation of the metaverse and web 3.0 technologies. Moreover, an assessment of the history and potential of these technologies is considered. Additionally, an evaluation of the available literature reviews between 1992 and 2022 was conducted. The assessment identified enormous attention on this scope from diverse multidisciplinary fields ranging from virtual reality, augmented reality, quantum communication, and blockchain. In the next ten years, expected progress is expected concerning metaverse and web 3.0 technologies. Consequently, these technologies will significantly impact how users interact with one another and how they associate with the internet. In this paper, we address the current security challenges and opportunities with the rise of the metaverse.

1 Introduction

Since the introduction of the internet, dynamic advancements have been observed in cyberspace. These advancements have been observed in virtual technologies, social networking, video conferencing, and augmented reality applications, among others. Over recent years, increased attention has been placed on the advancement of virtual reality technologies, leading to the introduction of the metaverse. The word metaverse simply means “beyond this world” which comes from a combination of two words, the first word “meta” meaning “beyond” and the second word “universe” meaning “this world”. Therefore, the term metaverse simply means “beyond this world.” The term metaverse has attracted varying definitions in recent years. Decker & Peterson [1] define the metaverse as a computer-generated world that exists beyond the metaphysical and spiritual domains of the physical realm.

The metaverse concept has advanced since its introduction in 1992 and has attracted varying definitions. Irrespective, the metaverse concept is associated with inferences

by Neal Stephenson in 1992. In his novel *Snow Crash*, Stephenson, who developed the term *metaverse*, presented the metaverse based on a virtual world perspective [2]. Consequently, Stephenson considered the metaverse as a massive virtual environment that seeks to align with the physical world and at the same time allows users to interact as digital avatars. The introduction of this concept has attracted varying interpretations from diversified concepts over the decades. Dionisio et al. [2] explain that numerous studies have considered the metaverse as *lifelogging*, a collective space in virtuality, or the mirror world. Irrespective of these viewpoints, there is no concrete definition of the term.

The concept of the metaverse got little attraction and popularity in public over the last three decades. However, diverse inferences have been critical in advancing public knowledge on this concept. Decker & Peterson [1] explain that in 2018, the concept of Metaverse was presented in a project termed OASIS. The movie *Ready Player One* and the novel were based on the concept of project OASIS. This concept had enormous inference and was critical in advancing the concept's popularity. This concept was also applied in the *Fortnite* project and concerts where musicians such as Travis Scott and Ariana Grande held mega concerts.

The concept of metaverse attracted the most attention following the actions of Mark Zuckerberg, CEO of Facebook. In October 2021, Facebook announced its plan to change its name to Meta. The name change is marked to reflect the commitment of Zuckerberg to advancing the concept and the integration of the idea with Facebook. This action was further promoted by the company's increased investment in the metaverse. Following this announcement, public attention was drawn to the concept of the metaverse, attracting large companies, individuals, and states to the possibilities of the metaverse. According to Zuckerberg, the metaverse will serve as the next big computing platform compared to smartphone and mobile web development. The actions of Facebook marked an evolution aspect of the metaverse. Decker & Peterson [1] explain that increased Google search interest was experienced since the announcement.

On the other hand, major brands, and companies, including Google, Nike, Microsoft, gaming companies, and Tick-Tock, have explored ways of advancing the metaverse concept. It is essential to acknowledge that though there are numerous potentials associated with the metaverse, little inference has been developed. However, the concept has enormous potential, hence the need to identify possible adoptions of the metaverse in the future. Peterson [1] further notes that the future will be characterized by a shift from 2d to 3d metaverse applications. The application of the 3d metaverse is a concept under development; however, its establishment has not been realized, especially for large-scale usage. However, this concept may be available in the future. Further, the metaverse concept will connect the users and the brands, hence posing enormous inferences to product development processes note that the first paragraph of a section or subsection is not indented. The following is how the rest of the paper is structured: The introduction is covered in section I, and the related work is covered in section II. Then, section III describes web 3.0. Section IV describes current approaches for known challenges. V explains the proposed solution. Section VI describes the metaverse in the age of quantum computing.

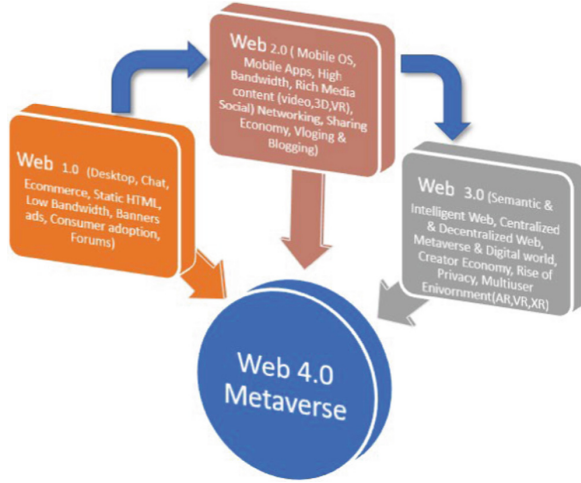


Fig. 1. Evolution of Metaverse.

Section VII talks about proficient multi-sided platforms and the security challenges of the metaverse. Section VIII describes the proposed architecture. Sections IX and X present analysis and discussion respectively. Finally, section XII concludes the research paper.

2 Related Works

Metaverse is a broad concept, attracting increased academic inferences in recent years. Over the past years, numerous studies have been established to seek and understand this concept. This section focuses on a range of related literature reviews that focus on the metaverse. One of the most insightful research projects was the Metaverse Roadmap which source to establish literature applicable in large systems of virtual environments. This study identified the Metaverse as a massive infrastructure that demanded the incorporation of interlinked virtual worlds. The establishment of this infrastructure is also required to transfer the internet from 2D to 3D.

These inferences were further advanced by the IEEE Virtual World group, which acknowledged that the establishment of the metaverse required was only possible from an individual virtual world. Dionisio et al. [2] explain that the progressive move from a particular world requires the establishment of separate worlds, commonly considered meta worlds. Over time and through technological advancement, an interconnected system is established, creating a hyper-grid or metagalaxies. Dionisio et al. [2] explain that metagalaxies are virtual environments that allow perceived teleportation from one region to another. This development eventually culminates in an entire metaverse composed of meta-galaxies and meta-world systems.

The metaverse essentially demands the integration of the duality of the physical and digital worlds. In achieving this duality, Leei et al. [6] explain that the metaverse must undergo diverse developments. The first development is the digital twins, which demands the inclusion of a high-fidelity digital model in the virtual scene. Consequently, the digital

twins require for inclusion of factors such as temperature, motion, and functioning of diverse scopes. The second stage is the digital native, which is expected to be achieved through avatars which are digital creations that represent the real world. The third key stage is surrealistic and involves creating a setup that supports physical and virtual reality coexistence. Incorporating these stages will be critical; however, research on these applications is still at the infant stage.

The realization of a metaverse is still in progress, and the complete Implementation may take some time. Nevertheless, diverse researchers have sought to identify computational advances or critical factors in the advancement of virtual reality. In a study by Leei et al. [6], there are four key features essential in virtual world technology: psychological realism, the ubiquity of access, interoperability capabilities of content, and scalability. Psychological realism focuses on the ability of metaverse technology to transport a user from the physical to the virtual world. This scope demands both psychological and emotional engagement supported by the virtual environment.

The concept of an applicable virtual world is founded on the criteria that it offers an abundance of human interaction. Microsoft Research [8] explain that this concept is considered ubiquity and may be achieved through users' ability to transverse through the virtual environment while holding varying interactions with other users. On the other hand, this ubiquity demands the incorporation of perception factors in the virtual world similar to the physical world. Researchers also identified the critical relevance of interoperability infrastructure in the metaverse. These technologies essentially serve to enhance the ubiquity of the technology. This concept demands the inclusion of layered structures in technology, allowing users to interact irrespective of their physical differences.

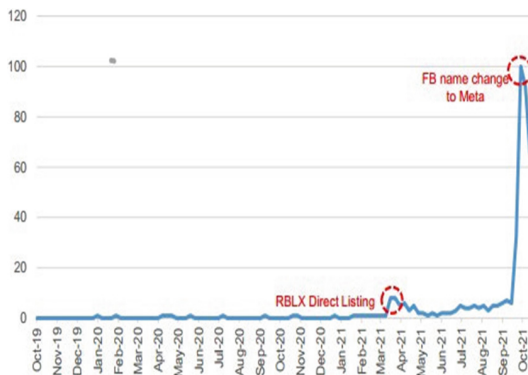


Fig. 2. Google Statistics following Metaverse mention by Facebook.

The final scope identified in the research was scalability. According to Liu et al. [7], three scalability dimensions are vital in establishing the metaverse: concurrent avatars, scene complexity, and avatar interactions. The contemporary avatars demand that the metaverse hold many users interacting with each other. On the other hand, an efficient metaverse must ensure that the level of detail in the diverse scenes is complex, serving as a representation of the real world. The final aspect focused on the Avatar interactions and required the metaverse to accommodate a range of avatar interactions (Fig. 2).

3 Challenges in WEB 3.0

The establishment of the metaverse is greatly dependent on the technological capability of transforming the internet from web 3.0. Web 3.0 essentially requires an integrated web where machines can efficiently interpret data. Web 3.0 will facilitate a word-wide data warehouse that allows for the sharing of data through any device or network. Web 3.0 is not confined to browsers or screens; instead, it is a web in a world of multi-devices, multi-channels, and metaverses. The theoretical presentation of Web 3.0 has attracted varying interpretations from diverse people resulting in disparity in opinions.

According to theorists, web 3.0 will be characterized by a range of challenges. Kreps & Kimppa [4] explain that one major challenge that will most likely be evident is the adoption process. Humans have failed to adopt certain technological initiatives throughout history due to fear of these devices. Therefore, there may be some form of resistance to adopting this technology. On the other hand, the adoption of web 3.0 will also face the challenge of privacy constraints. According to Kreps & Kimppa [4], web 3.0 is an advancement of web 2.0 characterized by significant privacy issues. Theorists have postulated that these challenges may be carried over into web 3.0.

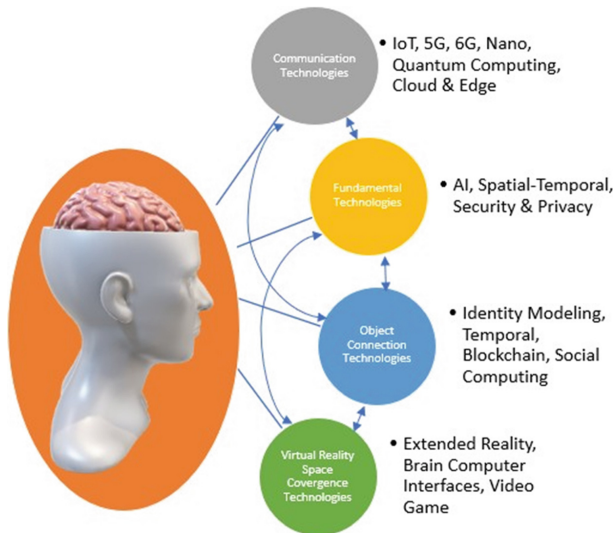


Fig. 3. Components of the Metaverse.

As it exists presently, the internet is characterized by the presence of large chunks of information. Itinson [3] explains that the vastness of the internet poses enormous challenges to the implementation of web 3.0, and hence almost impossible to read these diverse semantics. On the other hand, the internet is considered vague, and therefore various queries are not specific and thus vague. Itinson [3] further notes the implementation of Web 3.0 is also faced with increased uncertainty which results in varying solutions. On the other hand, the internet is inconsistent and results from unreliable data (Fig. 3).

4 Approaches to Challenges

The establishment of Web 3.0 faces diverse challenges; however, various theoretical frameworks seek to offer solutions to these challenges. Kreps & Kimppa [4] explains that the challenges of Web 3.0 may be analyzed based on their key scopes; focus on technology, focus on social meaning, and public perception. The technological aspect was best retaliated by studies by Lassila and Hendler in 2007. Lassila & Hendler [5] explain that the existing challenges on Web 3.0 are founded on the wealth of data facing the internet. This concept has commonly been considered Big Data, critical in advancing the Internet of Things. Based on these inferences, it is essential to acknowledge that Web 3.0 is a semantic web technology that incorporates large web applications that significantly differ from the Internet of Things.

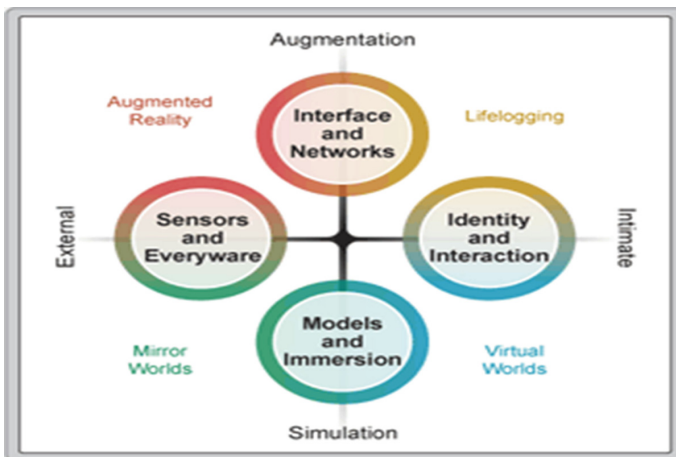


Fig. 4. Necessities of the Metaverse.

The establishment of Web 3.0, similar to the internet of things, has resulted in varying opinions. Consequently, diverse theorists have focused on this understanding, posing immense issues. Overcoming this challenge will demand an accurate knowledge of modern technology beyond this social network viewpoint. Kreps & Kimppa [4] note that the phenomenon has also been identified as a depiction of Web 2.0. Consequently, diverse scholars have acknowledged that there will be minor changes in web 3.0 culture. Based on these inferences, it is arguably based on the cultural construct of Web 2.0, which is immensely influenced by business rhetoric. This issue is prevalent, making it almost impossible to counter; however, there is a need for more understanding of the relevance of the technology (Fig. 4).

Web 3.0, from a theoretical point, is dependent on the technological advancements required. Mark Zuckerberg, one of the greatest proponents of web 3.0, has acknowledged that there is a need for increased improvement in technology to ensure that the technology is achieved. Moreover, it is estimated that the technology may take over ten years to accomplish due to the technological demands of the internet. This challenge is currently

being addressed through increased involvement in research and technology development by significant organizations such as Meta, Google, and Microsoft, among others.

Web 2.0 has faced enormous challenges in terms of privacy. In a growing society characterized by technological advancement, privacy issues and threats to the internet continue to be prevalent issues. A majority of scholars have considerably associated this challenge with Web 3.0. The theoretical viewpoint on Web 3.0. Indicate that this technology will serve diverse roles, and hence privacy issues raise the greatest concern [4]. First, it is vital to acknowledge that web 3.0 is theoretical, and therefore there is insufficient knowledge to define how best the technology will function. Nevertheless, the internet has experienced growth in privacy policies and practices that seek to eliminate the challenge of privacy. Therefore, it is possible that following the establishment of the technology, these policies will be adopted to ensure privacy concerns are addressed on the new platform.

The final challenge identified relates to the vastness of internet 2.0 and the inability of modern technology to effectively make use of the available data to drive the required results. The vastness of the internet may, to the point, be most beneficial to the adoption of Web 3.0. First, web 3.0 requires enormous amounts of data to achieve, and this is easily achieved through the available data on the internet. Moreover, there is a need to integrate diverse scopes of the internet during the development of web 3.0 [5]. This advancement will be critical in ensuring that web 3.0 can wholly integrate the vast nature of the internet. On the other hand, web 3.0 seeks to create a broad network of web networks that can encompass these large data variables.

5 Proposed Solutions

The introduction of the Metaverse is characterized by the presence of varying challenges. One of the primary challenges that may be experienced relates to privacy threats. Privacy continues to be a prevalent challenge even with web 2.0. One critical aspect of privacy that will demand immediate attention relates to possible privacy leakages, raising varying concerns. Consequently, varying researchers have sought to define practical solutions to this issue. One recommended requirement for the redesigning of privacy criteria from the onset. This recommendation requires the developers to redesign privacy frameworks from scratch. Essentially, establishing these solutions will be critical in eliminating privacy concerns before they advance with time, posing greater challenges to Web 3.0.

About privacy, a growing concern has been raised over the collection of user information and their willingness to share the information posing a privacy paradox. As evidenced by web 2.0, most users have opted to share their information willingly, and the information collected is used to guide marketing practices [9]. Consequently, the advancement of Metaverse will demand the incorporation of modern technology that seeks to eliminate these challenges by adopting varying recommendations. One vital recommendation requires the absolute termination of user information-sharing mechanisms.

The technological advancement of the metaverse is expected to be guided by web 2.0. Consequently, there is a likelihood that these systems will share numerous similarities. Researchers have hence sought to eliminate these challenges by establishing new cultures with innovative technology. Consequently, theorists have sought to pay

increased focus on a range of interconnected challenges. Garon [9] explains that these challenges include user diversity, cyberbullying, fairness, and user addiction. First, it is crucial to acknowledge that with the adoption of recent technology, it is expected that these cultural challenges will most likely be experienced with the new technology. This creates the need to identify viable solutions that counter these challenges.

There are numerous viable solutions that theorists have focused on intending to eliminate these social challenges. The first recommendation demands the inclusion of algorithms that integrate easy detection of social challenges. Due to the dynamic technology to be adopted in the metaverse, scholars have urged the need to establish algorithms that can detect these social and unethical conduct. The second recommendation requires establishing strict policies that seek to reduce social threats associated with the adoption of the recent technology.

6 The Metaverse in the Age of Quantum Computing

Data is dramatically shaping the future of all humankind through algorithmic innovation, driving rapid advances in artificial intelligence, and bringing us closer to a safe and responsible Human-AI symbiosis. Over the last decade alone, the rapid proliferation of data and cognitive analytics enabled worldwide exponential growth for the digital economy, unlocking breakthrough scientific and technological advances and new market opportunities, virtually in every industry.

In digital marketing and advertising (AdTech), media agencies, marketers, and data publishers have harnessed customer PII and NON-PII data from CRM, behavioral data from connected devices, online and in-store commerce transactions, social media engagements, and audience intelligence from Search cloud platforms to better segment, target and run personalized, relevant and timely digital engagements and marketing campaigns that drive revenue conversion, audience reach, new customer acquisition and higher return on Ad Spend, leading to the rise of intelligent consumer-centric digital experiences and omnichannel commerce. Data is enabling retailers and brands worldwide to digitally transform at the edge. 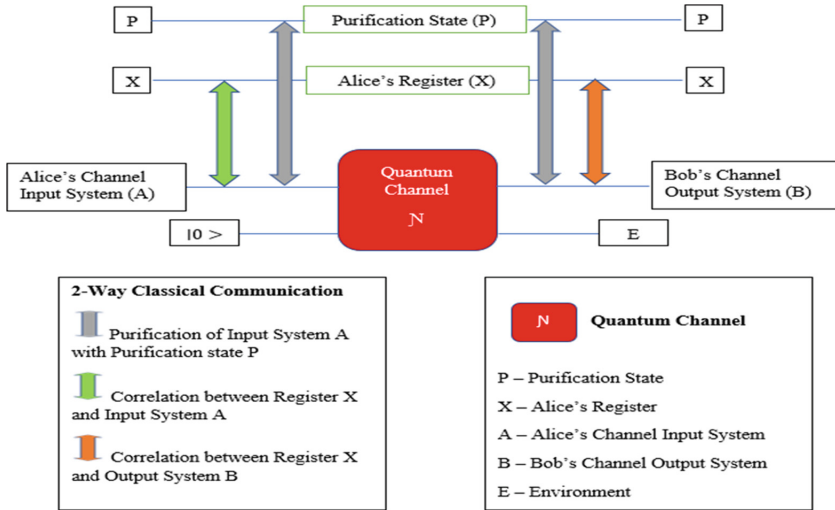


Fig. 5. Quantum Communication Models.

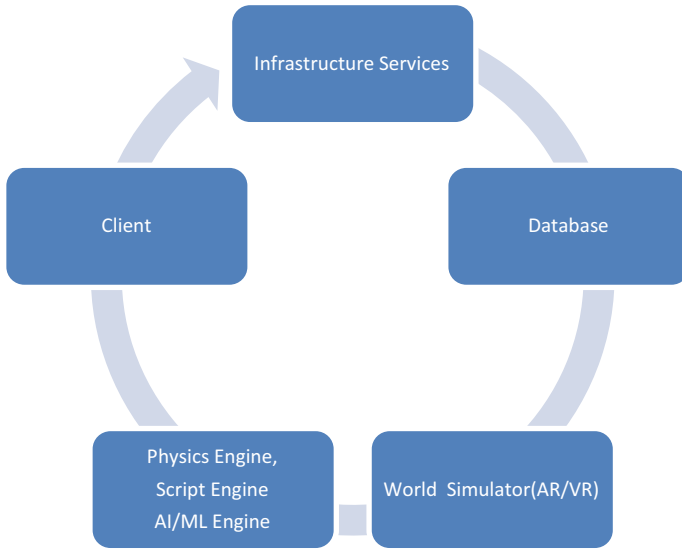


Fig. 6. The AI/ML-centric architecture used in virtual worlds

For example, the recent outbreak of teenagers was injured due to imitating short videos, family relationships broke down due to indulging in rewarding short video anchors, and people's property losses caused by false fund-raising news misleading. This limits the development space of the short video media metaverse. In recent years, the rapid iteration of emerging media technologies has led to the emergence of a large number of industry bubbles, and expectations of technological development can easily fall into the "progressive myth" criticized by Vincent Mosco (2009). Only by breaking the blind worship of technology can we find effective commercial landing scenarios for emerging media technologies. Practitioners must seriously reflect on what content means to their audiences, rebuild their own industry development rules, and ensure that the podcasting industry can maintain high-quality sustainable development (Nuzum, 2021). After a short burst of growth, podcasting has entered the track of healthy development of the bubble. Today's podcast may be tomorrow's metaverse. For the continuous development of media technology, while paying close attention to its development potential, it is also necessary to prudently judge possible industry bubbles and be alert to the "shining thing syndrome" in media technological change, so as to promote technological change to better serve the world Development of the news media industry.

6 Summary

It will break the boundaries between virtual and reality, online and offline, expand its boundaries infinitely, maintain the trend of sustainable development, surpass and break through the limitations of the previous generation of mobile Internet, and form a new "chaotic" universe. Beginning with the concept of the Metaverse and the application in educational Metaverse as the guidance, this paper discusses the ethical issues of educational Metaverse based on background of the Metaverse. Ultimately the biggest problem of the Metaverse is a human beings problem. That is to realize the purpose of people-oriented education. This paper mainly examines ethical problems of Metaverse from two aspects. Firstly, the problem of individual autonomy in the educational Metaverse is clearly specified. Secondly, we investigate the issues of privacy in the educational Metaverse. In addition, a series of minor problems such as data distortion, technical training and challenges for teachers are also discussed in detail.

1 Introduction

Since the outbreak of COVID-19 worldwide in 2020, people's travel in the real world is often restricted. More and more people move their lives and work to the Internet, such as telecommuting, online teaching and online conference, and so forth, which objectively accelerate the application and popularization of information technology. A large number of people need to spend more time online and in virtual spaces, and spend much more time in digital world. The impact on the traditional education mode of the outbreak of COVID-19 is enormous. In order to ensure the continuity and stability of the education, many countries and regions in the world have to accept online-to-offline teaching model. And this model advances rapidly. China, in particular, has made outstanding achievements in this regard. Online-to-offline study model has become a habitual learning style for contemporary Chinese students. Before the outbreak of COVID-19, there is already involved some blended teaching model in China, but its popularity is far from excellent. They are Blended Teaching Method and Flipped Class Model or Flipped classroom. The former has already combined the online teaching and offline teaching time and space and

its affiliated teaching resources as a whole, they are teaching resources, teaching means, teaching methods and teaching ideas [1]. And the latter refers to inverting the traditional learning process, let learners get targeted knowledge and the concept in extracurricular by autonomous learning, classrooms became a place for interaction between teachers and students, which are mainly used to answer doubts, do reports and discussions to achieve better teaching results [2].

According to the Metaverse Development Report 2020–2021 [3] released by the New Media Research Center of Tsinghua University, 2020 is the tipping point for the virtualization of human society. There are three reasons. Firstly, under the quarantine policy of COVID-19, the online time of the whole society has increased significantly, and the Otaku Economy has developed rapidly. As a result, the epidemic has accelerated social virtualization. Secondly, online life has changed from a short-term exception state to a normal state, from a supplement of real world to a parallel world with the real world; Thirdly, with the opening of online and offline, human real life has begun to migrate to the virtual world on a large scale, and human beings have become a real and digital ‘amphibious species’. This sets the stage for 2021 to be the first year of the Metaverse. Economist Jiaming Zhu believed that 2021 could be called the first year of the Metaverse. The explosion of the Metaverse is beyond imagination. Behind it is the critical mass effect of related elements of the Metaverse, which is similar to the Critical Mass experienced by the Internet in 1995 [4]. The rapid development of the Metaverse in the Internet will also cause changes in the educational model.

In January 2020, the World Economic Forum published the Schools of the Future Defining New Models of Education for the Fourth Industrial Revolution. In the context of the Fourth Industrial Revolution, Education 4.0: A Global Framework for Shifting Learning Content and Experiences Towards the Future has been put forward. In the report, it is redefining quality learning, calling for a critical shift in learning content and experience in global education, and proposing key approaches to innovative learning. It was mentioned in the report that Innova Schools in Peru has achieved very effective results by taking a multi-stakeholder approach to a collaborative blended-learning model.

Since the 18th National Congress of the Communist Party of China, The Party Central Committee centered by Xi Jinping attaches great importance to the education of contemporary college students. The report of the 19th National Congress of the Communist Party of China pointed out that ‘a country prospers when its youth flourish, and a country becomes stronger when its youth flourish. When the young generation is idealistic, capable and responsible, the country will have a future and the nation will have hope.’ It is difficult to stimulate the interest of students if they are lectured from the script, and it is more difficult to achieve the effect of entering the ear, into the brain and into the heart. Only innovation, the classroom can live, and then fire up. Xi Jinping attaches importance to the development of vocational education in China. In the new journey of building a modern socialist country in an all-round way, vocational education has a broad future and great potential [5]. Vocational education is closely linked to economic and social development, and it is of great significance to promoting employment and entrepreneurship, boosting economic and social development, and improving people’s well-being. China actively promotes the high-quality development of vocational education and supports

exchanges and cooperation in vocational education with other countries. China is ready to work with other countries to enhance mutual learning, joint contribution and shared benefits, jointly implement global development initiatives, and contribute to accelerating the implementation of the UN 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development [6]. How to improve the teaching quality of education and to enhance the ideological and political literacy of college students has become a hot topic among scholars at present. Therefore, beginning with the concept of the Metaverse and the application in educational Metaverse as the guidance, this paper discusses the ethical issues of educational Metaverse based on background of the Metaverse. Ultimately the biggest problem of the Metaverse is a people problem. That is to realize the purpose of people-oriented education. The remainder of this article is organized as follows. We give an introduction of related works in the Metaverse. In Sect. 3, the applications of the Metaverse in education is clearly described in detail. For Sect. 4, we discuss the ethical issues of educational Metaverse. Finally, the conclusions are summarized in Sect. 5.

2 Related Works

After the concept of the Metaverse became popular all over the world in 2021, the research on the Metaverse combined teaching in China and other countries increased year by year. The Metaverse is a kind of a mirror virtual world under the development of digital twin technology that integrates Augmented Reality (AR) based on virtual information of physical reality to supplement the information of real environment, Virtual Reality (VR) which presents virtual elements in virtual environment to simulate a kind of realistic reality and Mixed Reality (MR) which is a new visual environment produced by superimposing physical space and virtual space.

The term Metaverse first appeared in the book *Avalanche* by the famous science fiction writer Neil Stephenson in 1992. In this book, Neil Stephenson painted a picture of the hitherto futuristic Metaverse. ‘Hiro is approaching the Street. It is the Broadway, the Champs Elysees of the Metaverse. It is the brilliantly lit boulevard that can be seen, miniaturized and backward, reflected in the lenses of his goggles. It does not really exist. But right now, millions of people are walking up and down it.’ [7] In this virtual digital world that parallels to the real world, people in the real world have a virtual avatar in the Metaverse, and people use this virtual avatar to communicate and live.

It has been 20 years since the concept of the Metaverse appeared. However, people around the world have very different understandings of the Metaverse, and there is no recognized authoritative definition. Matthew Ball [8] offers a widely accepted definition in his article. The Metaverse is a massively scaled and interoperable network of real-time rendered 3D virtual worlds which can be experienced synchronously and persistently by an effectively unlimited number of users with an individual sense of presence, and with continuity of data, such as identity, history, entitlements, objects, communications,

and payments. Ashutosh Gupta [9] considers that the Metaverse is a collective virtual space, created by the convergence of virtually enhanced physical and digital reality. In other words, it is device-independent and is not owned by a single vendor. It is an independent virtual economy, enabled by digital currencies and nonfungible tokens (NFTs). A Metaverse represents a combinatorial innovation, as it requires multiple technologies and trends to function. Contributing tech capabilities include AR, flexible work styles, head-mounted displays (HMDs), an AR cloud, the Internet of Things (IoT), 5G, artificial intelligence (AI) and spatial technologies.

In China, according to the definition of the 2021 research report [10] by Tianfeng Securities, the Metaverse aims to create a virtual digital second world independent of the real world, enabling users to live freely as digital identities. The core is sustainability, real-time, no access restrictions (multiple terminals), economic function (having its own closed-loop economy), connectivity (connecting the real world through terminals), and creativity (PGC&UGC).

A team from Tsinghua University in Shenyang gave a comprehensive definition in the Metaverse White Paper [11]. The Metaverse is to integrate a variety of new technologies and to produce a new type of virtuality and reality combination of Internet applications and social form, which is based on extended reality technology which is providing immersive experience, based on the number of twin technology which is generating a mirror image of the real world, based on block chain technology which is structuring economic system and integrating the virtual world and real world in the economic system, social system, identity system closely. And it allows each user to do content production and world editing. It also argues that the Metaverse is still an evolving synopsis, with various participants enriching the meaning of the Metaverse in their own ways.

3 The Application of the Metaverse in Education

The concept of the Metaverse seems very complex. As a new upgrade and future ecology of the Internet, it embodies all the imagination of people for the future work, life, entertainment and other spiritual life. The core of Metaverse infrastructure is virtual technology, which is a three-dimensional virtual space with three 'I' features simulated by computer. That is, the Metaverse has the feature of imagination, immersion and interaction [12]. The elaborately made simulated space enables users to get immersive experience. It also opens up myriad possibilities for the future development of the educational Metaverse.

In Europe countries, Second Life [19], an open and free virtual reality platform developed by Linden Laboratories, was launched in 2003 and became the first phenomenal virtual world. Sweden became the first country to open a virtual embassy in Second Life in May 2007. Teachers could build teaching scenes and carry out task-based teaching in Second Life. Second Life provides an open learning space for language learners to communicate freely, and some of the world's top universities, such as Harvard University, has built virtual campuses through Second Life to pave the way for related research. Roblox [20] has been trying to reach into the education space for a long time while running its gaming community. The focus has been on a child's programming curriculum around its own game development programs. Through this series of official tutorials,

Roblox is able to convert a large number of ordinary players into game developers for the platform each year. And it keep them producing games for the platform, and its working. Roblox is devoting more resources to education. By partnering with schools and educational institutions to provide teachers with free handouts and lessons, Roblox has spread its programming classes to elementary and middle schools in the U.S. and abroad. Many teachers use the Roblox curriculum to teach programming, and hundreds of training institutions offer specialized Roblox programming classes. In addition, Roblox runs summer coding camps that take students to high schools and colleges to immerse in programming while learning about interpersonal communication and teamwork. In 2021, Roblox invested 10 million dollars to develop three educational games for middle school student, high school students and college students. One will teach robotics, one will focus on space exploration, and one will help students to learn careers and concepts in disciplines like computer science, engineering and biomedicine. The three games, which do not offer virtual goods for sale, are available in schools on a non-profit basis. The move to bring educational video games to classrooms around the world is part of Roblox's strategy to expand its user base and build a Metaverse.

Meta's cash burn began in October 2021, when Zuckerberg announced at Facebook Connect 2021 that Facebook was officially rebranding itself as Meta, making an all-out bet on the Metaverse. Zuckerberg posted a virtual selfie to Meta on August 16, 2022 to celebrate the launch of Horizon Worlds, a Metaverse social platform, in France and Spain. He then updated the photos again on Meta and Instagram. In contrast to the old image, the avatar appears more natural and three-dimensional with layered hair, added highlights in the eyes and more realistic ears. In addition, a contrast of light and shadow was added to make the figure appear more realistic.

Virtual reality platforms such as Second Life, Roblox, and Meta (Facebook) break through the limitations of the physical classroom to provide a free learning space, which is expected to integrate into a Metaverse of education in the future.

The educational Metaverse is also thriving at home. The first National VR and Visualization Technology and Application Conference was held in November 2001, which was sponsored by VR and Visualization Technology Committee of Chinese Computer Society and hosted by Academy of Armored Force Engineering and Beihang University. In order to improve the teaching quality and promote the development of higher education, the Ministry of Education of China launched the construction of the national virtual simulation experimental teaching center in 2015. In order to implement the relevant deployment of the 14th Five-Year education development plan and to accelerate the construction of virtual teaching and research offices, the General Office of the Ministry of Education of China announced the first batch of 439 [13] virtual teaching and research office construction pilot list on February 15, 2022, and the second batch of 218 [14] virtual teaching and research office construction pilot list on May 19. A total of 657 pilot construction projects have been approved twice. Beihang University has been approved 10 virtual teaching and research sections, including 4 courses (group) teaching, 3 professional construction, 2 teaching and research reform topics and 1 virtual teaching and research section for the compilation principle course of 101 Plan. More and more schools begin to study virtual simulation technology. In 2019, the Ministry of Education of China certified 401 [15] national virtual simulation experimental teaching

projects. On August 3rd, 2021, the Department of Vocational Education and Adult Education of the Ministry of Education of China determined 215 [16] vocational education demonstration virtual simulation training base cultivation projects. Among them, two schools in Shenzhen have been shortlisted as virtual simulation training bases, namely the intelligent ICT virtual simulation training base of Shenzhen Polytechnic and the 5G all-scene and all-business vocational education demonstration virtual simulation training base of Shenzhen Institute of Information Technology. Tencent, Bytedance, Baidu, NetEase and other companies are also actively engaged in virtual reality Metaverse business. With the development of science and technology and the promotion of policy, there are increasingly related researches in China and plenty of studies on the educational Metaverse.

4 The Ethical Issues of Educational Metaverse

At present, the Metaverse has not yet been formally born, but the ethical problems of the educational Metaverse can be seen by referring to the lessons of previous virtual worlds and the ethical problems presented by existing technologies such as big data and intelligent algorithms. Ultimately the biggest problem of the Metaverse is a human beings problem. That is how to achieve the purpose of people-oriented education.

Firstly, the problem of individual autonomy in the educational Metaverse is discussed. In January 2020, the World Economic Forum put forward the Global Framework for Education 4.0, which mentioned the suggestion of developing students' human-centered skills and moving towards a true learning-centered education. Global school systems are required to develop students' human-centric skills, those are cooperation, empathy, social awareness and global citizenship. Those skills can ensure that children take responsibility for shaping inclusive and equitable societies of the future. However, in the world of the educational Metaverse, human beings can use their imagination to build it. Anyone can have everything that they want in virtual world. In the educational Metaverse, education is no longer limited by time, place, identity and other restrictions. So will human beings transfer all education in the real society to the virtual society? Jeremy Bailenson's experiments [18] examined to what extent our avatars are extensions of ourselves. It showed that living in a virtual world also affects our offline behavior. In virtual interactions based on self-presentation, avatars can influence the users' perception, attitude and behavior, whether consciously or unconsciously, which is known as the Proteus effect in psychology. In a social setting, if something goes wrong with your avatar, it seems to trigger the same neural circuits as if something went wrong with the real you.

In terms of individuals following the social order, people will become increasingly domesticated in the Metaverse, while machines or virtual avatars will become more and more humanized, blurring the boundary between the virtual and the real. Are people subjects of the real world or the virtual world, or not subjects at all? Therefore, we should be alert to the humanistic crisis caused by the reversal of the relationship between man and technology [17].

On the social level, science and technology make people expect a fairer and more equal world, and make people expect more equal education. People used to think that

the Internet would change the current state of education and ordinary people could also receive the guidance of famous teachers on the Internet. However, this is not the case. It is always restricted by different institutions, economies and cultures. So will things change in the Metaverse? Zuckerberg has emphasized for many times that in the Metaverse, the way of decentralized entitlements will be realized and more decentralization will be realized. However, the function of the Metaverse is mainly to calculate, maintain and regulate, record users' footprints, identify directions, determine time and space, and establish data indexes. It is more widely used in the structure of people's daily life and the organization of power. It shows how data supports our existence. Intelligent algorithms which are ubiquitous in the Metaverse have simplified autonomy, that is, action autonomy, while moral autonomy is ignored by designers. In the process of program design, a lot of correlation thinking is adopted while causal thinking is weakened in order to establish connections and to make decisions in the complex events by algorithms. And then do humans still have moral autonomy in the Metaverse? The Metaverse integrates VR, AR, MR, 5G, cloud computing and other technologies. It is a highly motivated and highly institutionalized mandatory system, and general users are completely incapable of understanding its operation, let alone changing it. This algorithmic bias is an important information ethical problem in the era of algorithmic information. It has a non-neutral influence on users in the process of information production, distribution and verification, resulting in the spread of one-sided and inaccurate information concepts. Although the algorithm program can exist independently of manual operation and recommend information to users from a relatively objective standpoint, the deep-rooted bias that may be hidden in it has been constantly exposed in practice. How to maintain the uniqueness of human beings and adhere to the people-oriented ethics is the first ethical problem in the Metaverse age.

Secondly, the issue of privacy in the education Metaverse is studied. The value of the Metaverse to schooling is reflected in the field of learning, teaching and education, where the Metaverse creates an immersive learning experience. It brings an immersive learning environment. In the existing online education or blended education combining online and offline, teachers and students generally respond that this method can improve students' learning interest, attention, enthusiasm and innovation, relieve anxiety in real class, improve communication skills, and ultimately improve students' learning quality. In the Metaverse, it is a way not only to enable the real world, but also transcend the virtual environment. It can transcend the existing online teaching means, so that students can learn freely and productively. Students can immerse themselves in the learning environment with the immersive nature of virtual reality technology. They can explore the simulation scene in the way of personal experience and feel the scene content from the first perspective. Virtual reality technology can also help to enrich students' imagination and to improve their creative ability. Digitalization is an advantage of the educational Metaverse, which can make education more diversified and learning more diversified. But at the same time, in the process of building the educational Metaverse, a lot of data mining and analysis, such as human beings, real environment, physical existence, etc. are obtained from real life. Moreover, the builders of the educational Metaverse are some enterprises. These companies are in the hands of some people. They will master countless private information in the process of building the educational Metaverse, as a result the

ability to ensure the security of data is required. High and new technology will continue to be rapidly introduced and applied in school education. In the data collection of school environment and teaching links, AI technologies such as face recognition and voice recognition will be applied to provide comprehensive, convenient and visual quantitative indicators and management tools for educational managers at all levels to provide front-line teachers with data representations of students' learning behaviors, learning processes and learning outcomes, to provide personalized and adaptive learning guidance for each learner, and to achieve the goal of reducing burden, increasing efficiency, balancing quality education reform through the empowerment of educational technology. However, the special feature of the educational Metaverse is that in order to facilitate management, teachers and students also have to upload real information in the course of class, including the personal information of teachers, work units, students' personal information, courses learned, and so on. The data is taken from the real world. The educational Metaverse with artificial intelligence as its core technology completely depends on data for its decision-making ability, and data will bring privacy problems. How to ensure the security of these data is a big problem to be considered in the educational Metaverse.

Of course, the educational Metaverse will also face some other challenges, such as data distortion, technical training, teacher challenges, and so on. If the individual shapes the personal virtual image in educational Metaverse, considering to hidden identity, they fill in the data distortion, which leads to their images in the education Metaverse neither completely true personality of virtualization, nor of the will of individual real full expression. Most images are just partial reflection to people's real personality, sometimes even the opposite. This distorted data is bound to hamper the popularity of the education industry in the Metaverse. The educational Metaverse is the result of the integration and development of multiple technologies, which means that after the construction of the educational Metaverse, a large number of technical personnels are needed to provide technical training for ordinary teachers to improve their computer-aided instruction ability and information level, which takes a long time and costs a lot. The information technology of contemporary college students in China is extremely developed, and most of them can adapt to the changes brought by the educational Metaverse in a very short time. If the teachers cannot increase their knowledge reserve as soon as possible, the gap between teachers and students will be widened invisibly. This raises the panic of teachers' professionalism. Teachers not only have certain pressure in classroom design, but also have a large workload in after-class testing and evaluation. In the process of teaching, there may be strangers' trespass, spread violence, illegal information and other problems, which bring great difficulty to teachers' teaching management.

5 Conclusions

The ideal educational Metaverse is a utopia world of high freedom, high openness and high tolerance. It is a collection of various complex relations in real society. How to construct the ethical framework of the educational Metaverse in the decentralized framework still needs to be explored from multiple perspectives. As a surreal virtual

space, it is necessary to mine and upload the identity attributes, physiological reactions and social relations of the participants of the educational Metaverse, which will inevitably involve the disclosure of personal information. How to manage and use these data and how to prevent crimes based on these data is a big challenge.

From the Internet to the mobile Internet and to the Metaverse, technology is developing rapidly. The deep integration of science and technology and education is the inevitable development direction of future education. The educational Metaverse created by the richness and integration of virtual reality platform can realize the normalization of teaching resources to share and to communicate. The educational Metaverse gives a new meaning to traditional education, and enriches traditional teaching from content to scene. However, virtual reality technology does not deny the traditional education model, nor can it replace the responsibility of teachers. Teachers act as guides and leaders in the integration of science and technology into teaching that should combine the development of technology, treat technology from a rational perspective, and promote the integration of industry-university-research teaching.

The era of Metaverse needs vocational schools to cognize the Metaverse objectively and make use of the Metaverse technology to empower vocational education, to promote the reform of teaching methods in vocational education, and to solve the difficulties in vocational education. At the same time, we should calmly analyze the possible challenges of privacy risk, ethical risk, addiction risk, and consider the effective measures to prevent the risk from occurring, with a view to providing some reference and inspiration for the high-quality development of the vocational education.

1 Introduction

The year 2021 is called the first year of the Metaverse, with the renaming of Facebook as Meta, the world's largest social media site, the capital investment and development potential of many domestic and foreign companies in the Metaverse have been activated. The Metaverse will not only completely change the mode of human social communication, life and work, but also completely change the mode of human learning, which has aroused heated discussion in the field of education. The outbreak and spread of Covid-19 has accelerated technological change in education and restarted large-scale online education across the country, with far-reaching and more sophisticated online learning models developing significantly faster in the face of adversity, the integration of technology and education is getting closer and closer, but the problems such as insufficient interaction, insufficient contextualization and poor learning experience have not been effectively solved. The educational field is one of the core application scenarios of the Metaverse, and the integration of the Metaverse and education will bring profound changes to the existing educational work.

As one of the types of education, the vocational education universe of education will give new impetus and direction to its development. Therefore, this paper analyzes the

Some researchers believe that Metaverse is based on technologies such as digital twins, artificial intelligence, human-computer interaction, Internet of Things, and high-speed communication. It is created to meet people's needs for deep immersion, cross-domain social entertainment, and surreal creation. An ecological civilization space that is parallel to the real world and independent of the integration of the real world and society.

Regardless of the current interpretation of the perspective of the Metaverse, that the Metaverse is after the PC Internet and mobile internet after the new generation of the Internet has become a common understanding. The Metaverse is an important part of the digital economy era and the next stage of the Internet. It consists of augmented reality (AR), virtual reality (VR), mixed reality (MR), immersive vision, blockchain, cloud computing, Digital Twins, artificial intelligence, big data, 3D and other technologies to support the virtual reality world, is driving the entire world from the industrial era to the digital economy era upgrade.

2.2 The Properties of the Educational Metaverse

Metaverse provides a new breakthrough educational environment and tools for education, which can provide teachers and learners with an immersive interactive field of teaching, to meet the teaching and learning needs of teachers and students in the physical world and virtual world. The integration of the Metaverse and the field of education is bound to contain infinite possibilities for development. In 2021, the government work report proposes to accelerate the construction of new infrastructure. In July, six major departments including the Ministry of Education issued guidelines on promoting the construction of new infrastructure for education and a high-quality education support system. In January 2022, the key points of the Ministry of Education's work were also put forward to implement the strategic action of education digitalization.

From the perspective of application scope, the Metaverse of education has the characteristics of virtual and reality interweaving, human and machine cooperation, and school and society connection.

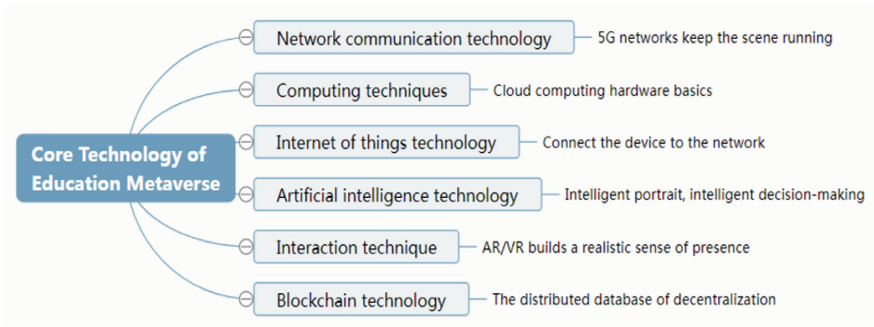


Fig. 1. Schematic diagram of the main core technologies of the education Metaverse

From the perspective of the technical framework, the education Metaverse requires high-speed data transmission technology and strong computer processing capabilities, and requires the support of core technologies such as network communication technology, computing technology, Internet of Things technology, artificial intelligence technology, interactive technology, and blockchain technology. Network communication technology. Education Metaverse needs a smooth network environment to support the normal operation of large-scale virtual mirror learning scenarios. 5G network technology can meet the transmission requirements of Metaverse's massive data and ensure the operation of virtual learning scenarios. Computing technology. The application scenarios of the education cloud universe have high requirements on the performance of the

client and the carrying capacity of the equipment, such as 3D graphics rendering in educational applications. Cloud computing technology transfers the data processing work in the Metaverse to the data center for processing. After processing, it is transmitted to the user side, which can solve the problem of insufficient computing power on the user side and provide a solid hardware environment foundation for teaching scenarios. Internet of Things technology. Use information sensors to connect devices in the real world with the network according to specific communication protocols, providing a transmission channel for the education Metaverse to perceive signals from the physical world and access the education Metaverse. Artificial intelligence technology. Thanks to the rapid development of current artificial intelligence technology, intelligent tutors, intelligent assessment, intelligent decision-making, etc. have been widely developed and application. Interaction technology. Through the integration of visual interaction technologies such as virtual reality (VR) and augmented reality (AR), it brings teachers and students immersion and flow state of seamless transition between the virtual world and the real world, providing a deep immersion experience and an immersive interactive experience. Blockchain technology. The decentralization, distribution, traceability, high trust and other technical features of this technology ensure the integrity and security of the data and information generated in the process of education management and teaching, which can be used for the certification of learning outcomes, credit bank construction, digital resource management and distribution, ecological construction of open educational resources, self-organized operation of digital campus communities, etc., provide knowledge sharing and certification guarantees based on rules and algorithm operations (Fig. 1).

3 The Application Prospect of Metaverse in Vocational Education

Vocational education, as one of the types of education in my country, cultivates high-quality modern talents with professional theoretical knowledge and practical operation ability. Today, the elements of vocational education are undergoing profound changes. Artificial intelligence, online and offline hybrid teaching, and virtual simulation technology have achieved good development in the field of vocational education. Information

technology empowers vocational school teaching and vocational training. It has become a kind of The new normal. However, the current vocational education still has problems such as insufficient teachers, weak learning motivation, and loose structure of production and education, which impede the improvement of the quality of vocational education. The education Metaverse provides new ways, means that many new possibilities for vocational education, which is expected to promote the high-quality development of vocational education. However, the specific impact path and degree of influence of the education Metaverse on vocational education remains to be explored. This paper analyzes the current predicament in the development of vocational education, and then starts from the core technologies of the education Metaverse to explore the specific applications of these technologies in vocational education, and how the occurrence of these applications will affect the ecology of vocational education.

3.1 The Main Difficulties in Vocational Education Development

Affected by the COVID-19, vocational colleges have effectively alleviated the problem of separation of time and space in teaching through online teaching, and maintained the normal teaching work of vocational schools in order to realize suspended classes without teaching, and without stopping learning. VR/AR technology has also begun to play a role in the field of vocational education. Seoul National University Hospital in South Korea used VR/AR technology to share real-time surgery at the 29th online academic conference of the Asian Society of Cardiovascular and Thoracic Surgery. However, some research studies have pointed out that when the characteristics of the given matching samples are consistent, the learning effect of online students is unsatisfactory, and most experimental courses and practical training courses are postponed until after returning to school, which affects the teaching goal of integrating theory and practice. In addition to these new problems, there are still low social recognition in the field of vocational education, imperfect vocational education system design, school-enterprise cooperation mere formality, mismatch between enterprise demand and talent supply, uneven teacher level, and lack of students' motivation to learn, the lack of professional experience and other problems and predicaments restrict the high-level development of vocational education.

3.1.1 The Social Recognition of Vocational Education is Low, and the Design of Vocational Education System is not Perfect

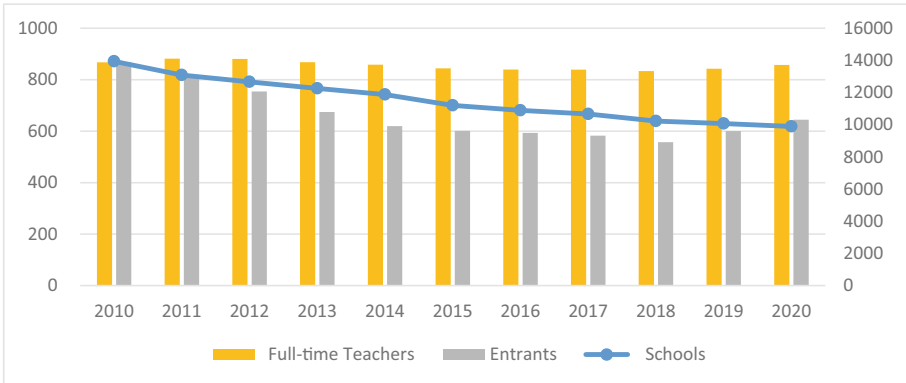


Fig. 2. Changes in the development trend of secondary vocational schools from 2010 to 2020 (unit: 10,000 people, 1000 school). Data source: Based on statistics from the Ministry of Education

Students' access to higher education is blocked. Before the 1990s, technical secondary schools and junior colleges were favored by people, but after the expansion of higher education, these degrees lost their original aura. According to the 2020 data from the National Statistical Bulletin on the Development of Education, there were 182 fewer secondary vocational schools than the previous year. The number of students enrolled in vocational colleges has dropped year by year from 2010, and it has not recovered until 2019. Compared with 2010, the number of students in secondary vocational schools in 2020 has dropped by about 26%. Moreover, due to the imperfect design of the vocational education system, there is a lack of opportunities for vocational talents to adjust and choose, and there are insurmountable barriers between applied universities and

comprehensive universities, and it is difficult to meet the needs of vocational talents to increase their studies (Fig. 2).

3.1.2 School-Enterprise Cooperation is a Mere Formality, and There is a Mismatch Between Enterprise Demand and Talent Supply

In the past, vocational education provided solely by schools was out of touch with the actual needs of society. In addition to the outdated curriculum content, which was difficult to update in time with industrial progress, the teaching content was often a generic version, which was difficult to connect with the refined needs of enterprises. Therefore, many graduates of vocational colleges cannot get good job opportunities due to insufficient skill training, and enterprises are in short supply because they cannot recruit suitable skilled talents. Taking the automotive industry as an example, the current automotive majors are generally EFI electronic control and new energy intelligence, but some schools are still evaluating carburetor models. Vocational education is also trying to solve such problems by strengthening school-enterprise cooperation. However, due to the high mobility of technical personnel, enterprises cannot see a favorable input-output ratio and are unwilling to really invest in the long-term school-enterprise co-education process. It makes school-enterprise cooperation a mere formality and fails to really play an effective role.

3.1.3 There Are Differences in the Construction of Teaching Staff

In recent years, although my country has made certain achievements in the construction of vocational education teachers, there are still many deficiencies: Affected by factors such as natural geographical conditions, policies and regional economic levels, the teachers in underdeveloped areas are relatively small, and information The ability to apply technology needs to be strengthened. More teachers directly graduated from school to teach in vocational schools. They have insufficient experience in social practice and

lack of knowledge updating ability. They need to be improved in terms of professional knowledge, teaching ability and comprehensive quality.

3.1.4 Students Lack Motivation in Learning and Lack of Professional Experience

Due to the weak learning foundation of most students in my country's vocational education and the poor subjective ability of learning, most of them are forced to be diverted. In the traditional classroom teaching method, the teacher is the lecturer of the classroom teaching, and the students accept and learn in a fixed manner, becoming a machine that passively accepts knowledge, and the learning process is quite boring. If students do not stimulate the subjective ability of learning, they will gradually lose their enthusiasm and self-confidence in learning. Moreover, before choosing a major, during the learning process, students in vocational colleges have few opportunities for career exploration and do not understand the real professional working environment, making it difficult to meet the changing development needs of enterprises after leaving the campus, or It is difficult to accept the reality of the working environment, thus giving up the major and engaging in work that does not correspond to the major.

3.2 The Application of Education Metaverse in Vocational Education

Applying new technologies to vocational education must be the only way for the development of the times. Education Metaverse technology enhances the interaction, immersion and sense of acquisition of the learning process of vocational education through scene empowerment, and provides a cheaper and more realistic skills training platform, breaking the online classroom of vocational education brought by two-dimensional network technology. Development bottleneck.

3.2.1 Application Scenarios of Education Metaverse Empowering Vocational Education

Artificial intelligence technology, Digital intelligent teachers provide personalized and innovative education. Teachers play a vital role in education and teaching, but from the reality of our country's current vocational colleges, there is still a shortage of high-quality double-qualified teachers. Using Metaverse, artificial intelligence and other technologies to create digital intelligent teachers can solve the problem of lack of teachers to a certain extent. Create digital intelligent teachers for specific majors and specific courses in vocational colleges, provide students with educational services at any time, answer students' questions, and provide personalized education for each student, which will alleviate the shortage of teachers in vocational colleges to a certain extent. so that students can feel the care and education of teachers at any time, so that education is always present and ubiquitous.

AR/VR interactive technology, create an immersive interactive teaching environment. In the field of education, immersion and interactivity are the most prominent advantages of VR technology. Based on VR/AR-based visual immersion technology, the virtual-real interface for learning the Metaverse becomes the access point for learning the Metaverse. Using human-machine interface equipment, network, cloud computing and other

technologies, develop a targeted teaching environment for vocational education courses based on the Metaverse, and map the teaching content knowledge of high-level teachers, so that teachers and students can learn in a surreal environment. Immersive interactive teaching, as described in movies such as *The Matrix* and *Ready Player One*, teachers and students can learn, live and make friends in a virtual digital world by wearing human-machine interface devices, reshaping education and learning environment to promote deep learning and cognitive development of learners.

Virtual teaching equipment, reduce the cost of vocational education skills practice. Vocational colleges need to purchase and equip corresponding teaching equipment to train qualified industrial workers. However, teaching equipment is often expensive. Fiscal and taxation simulation platforms, industrial automation process platforms, etc. often require millions of funds. The school's site environment is very demanding, and some equipment upgrades and changes quickly, which puts forward higher requirements for vocational colleges. The lack of vocational skills practice environment is an important practical dilemma faced by vocational colleges, especially in underdeveloped areas and vocational colleges with tight funding. AR/VR can simulate expensive teaching equipment, and at the same time restore 100% mechanical equipment, it can also assist teachers in teaching, which greatly saves education costs. In vocational education, digital virtual teaching equipment is widely used to carry out practical training operations, which has broad market prospects and practical value in my country. At present, in aerospace, military and other fields, high-simulation digital virtual equipment is widely used in training; in general civilian industries, the fidelity, popularization and professionalism of digital virtual equipment need to be improved.

Blockchain technology, Promote the construction, sharing and sharing of digital resources featuring vocational education. The platform is the basic carrier of information-based education and teaching services. In recent years, certain achievements have been made in the construction of information-based platforms. For example, in March 2022, the National Smart Education Cloud Platform was officially launched. High-quality resources in the field have built an open and shared platform service model. However, there are still problems such as the inability of interconnection between various educational platforms at all levels, inconsistent platform data standards, ineffective data aggregation, and repeated platform construction. Vocational college teachers can only choose some different information platforms for teaching, which is not conducive to the accumulation and sharing of resources. The technological development trend of Metaverse provides a starting point for solving such problems. Using application technologies represented by blockchain to formulate compatible standards and protocols can promote the interconnection between open source platforms and platforms, and help cross-regional and cross-platform, data flow and aggregation. In addition, the technical features of blockchain technology such as decentralization and traceability ensure the integrity and security of data and information generated in the process of education management and teaching, which can be used for learning achievement certification, credit bank construction, and digital resource management, and distribution, ecological construction of open educational resources, etc. to provide certification guarantees.

3.2.2 The Impact of Education Metaverse on Vocational Education Ecology

Education Metaverse uses technologies such as extended reality and digital twin to construct learning scenes, training scenes, and work scenes in virtual space, providing a highly realistic practical environment for teachers to carry out teaching activities. Participate in virtual practice, cultivate students' practical ability and operational skills, and solve difficult and difficult problems.

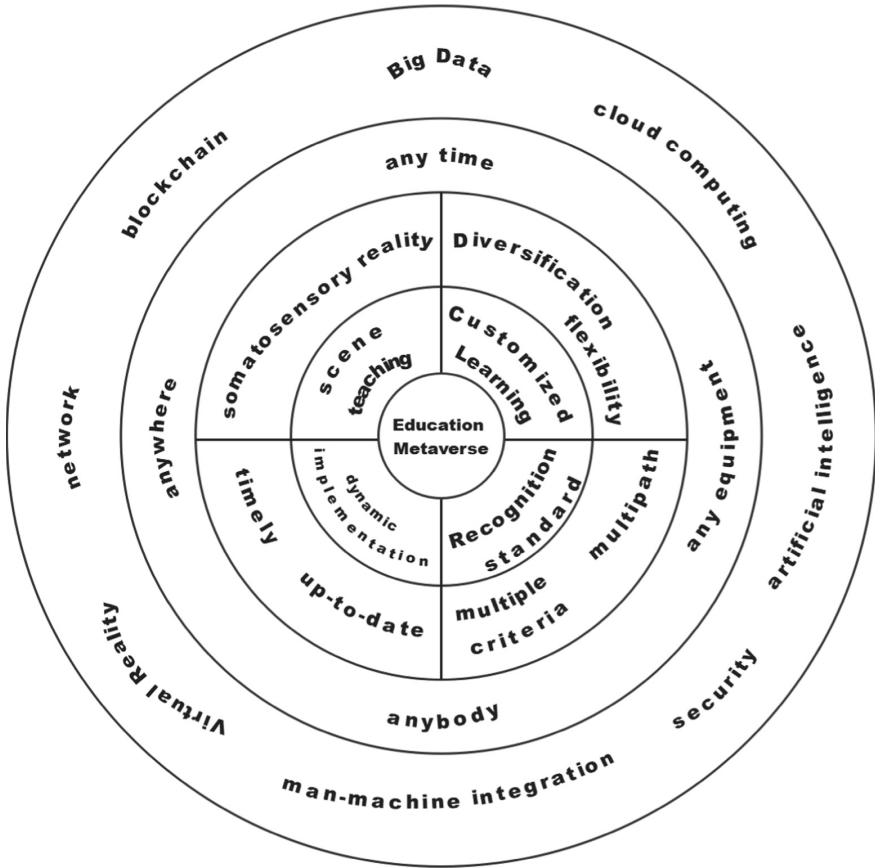


Fig. 1. Educational metaverse application scenario

In this case, when someone says that they need to refine, analyze, update and innovate the corresponding educational and teaching content suitable for each student, then the workload of the content of the metaverse will increase during the May Day, so for now, This is a relative disadvantage, but it could be an advantage in the future metaverse.

Teacher feedback is diverse and complex. The educational metaverse is about exploiting diverse knowledge and content to serve students and teachers as well as participants. However, this service will continue to develop more detailed and small conditions and guidelines according to the needs of students, teachers and other participants, the purpose is to meet their own needs and meet the needs of others. At the same time, students’ demand for knowledge will give teachers more feedback, and teachers should update the corresponding content based on this feedback. But the content of this feedback will become more and more complicated. Updating this kind of content in the early educational originals may require a lot of manpower, material resources, and financial resources, but when the metaverse develops to a certain extent, this has turned into an advantage.

The complexity of the management system has increased. When the metaverse enters the public eye, it means that all real environments will be integrated, transformed, and innovated again with the virtual network environment. New, innovative and inclusive management systems are needed. This kind of management system must not only constrain reality, but also manage the principles of virtual education, then it will inevitably increase the complexity of the management system’s setting and implementation, and in the process of continuous metaverse evolution, the complexity will deepen.

4.3 Opportunity

The realization of the education metaverse will bring earthshaking changes to education, and it is also a new round of education innovation. It is necessary to seize the opportunity and prepare for the development of the education metaverse.

Customized education. Since education comes from focusing on traditional teacher standards, teaching rules, training programs, training models, etc., there are mismatched characteristics. Therefore, it is necessary to formulate customized norms, standards, conditions, models, teaching methods based on the situation of one's own education metaverse, activity logic, etc. Then these can ensure the stable, safe and orderly operation of the education metaverse. Avatar teacher, that is, the teacher teaches in the form of an avatar; holographic teacher, that is, the teacher teaches in the form of a real mirror. With the use of the education park for a week, students can constantly switch the type of teacher, teaching method, teaching resources, teaching content, etc., so there will be non-uniform standards for judgment and informatization criteria for identification.

4.4 Threat

The limitation and elimination of ideological value system and morality. There is a big difference between the social activities of the education system and other systems, especially in the education assistance activities, the ideological and behavior of various participants will change greatly, which may appear in real life and the virtual world. There is a huge difference. Virtual worlds also have ethics. The government and all sectors of society should shoulder the responsibility of regulating cyberspace, ensuring the security of cyberspace and preventing technology abuse. Education originates from a constructed world that attaches great importance to the digital nature based on intelligent algorithms. Diversified applications and analysis are carried out through numbers, but how to transmit the correct ideological value system and build corresponding moral standards through this form is an A question worth pondering. Especially in the process of education principles, various actors will show their own thinking patterns and behavior patterns, then it will affect the thinking, behavior of other participating individuals at the same time, then this will cause certain security risks, no matter what. Whether it is ideological or behavioral, it will induce problems in other individuals in society. If this happens, how to restrict or limit the ideological value system and moral problems has become a very important and urgent problem to be solved.

Threats posed by immature technology. Although the education metaverse has gained a certain level and recognition on the underlying basis, it still has many technical difficulties that need to be broken through, especially in the current process of immersion and integration between the virtual environment and the offline environment. Under the condition that the machine switching is not natural and convenient enough, various operations are cumbersome and cannot be transferred with the change of consciousness, then the requirements for the design and application of the software, the surrounding WiFi, the network environment and the data environment are all Relatively high, including data system, identity system, economic system and integration of domestic and foreign systems and so on. So this has a certain weakening phenomenon for the educational metaverse, and if this problem cannot be solved, then it is a very important threat to educational reasons.

Threats to data security. The Education Metaverse has huge data resources. This data resource includes data acquisition, data transmission, data import, export, etc., then these components are subject to technological development, as well as the ability to acquire and transform data. The trader universe, if he is a characterizing data, needs to describe all the content into a set of data processes that can be converted at any time according to the environmental conditions at different time points, and this situation needs to be updated and improved in time. Learning resources and teaching applications that are more suitable for multimodal environmental content, knowledge structure, and activity games in the educational metaverse should be introduced.

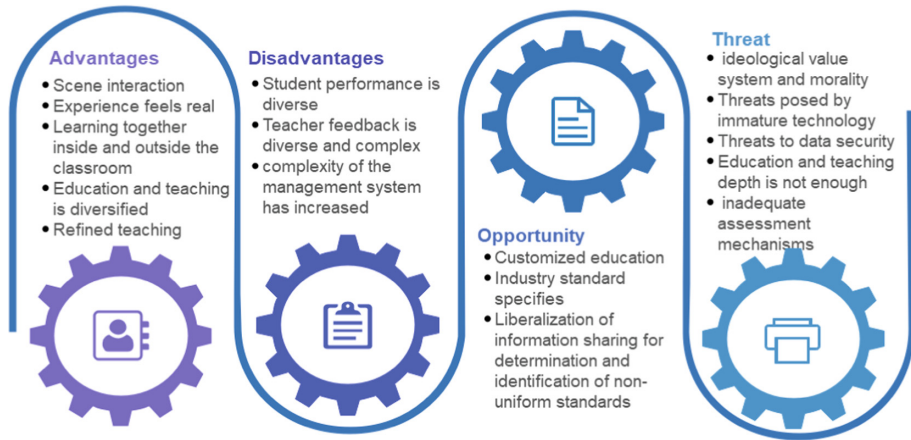


Fig. 2. Shows the strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and threats of SWOT analysis

Threats posed by inadequate assessment mechanisms. The education park universe is in the primary research and development state, and its application in the field of education is also advancing. So how can we better evaluate whether an education park universe is suitable for the current education situation and other mutual influencing factors? In general, it is extremely important, that is to say, teachers and students, good social units, etc. must be integrated with information network platform resources, and the scattered content must be merged into a complete system, in order to bring the educational principles into play. In order to maximize the utility, how to integrate them together is extremely important, and how to formulate a corresponding evaluation criterion is even more important (Fig. 2).

Abstract. At present, the traditional medical model is facing the prominent contradiction of the imbalance between supply and demand, and under the new background of the normalization of the new crown epidemic, the development of medical care is facing the transformation needs of prevention and control work, work focus and development concept. In order to explore the feasibility and application scenarios of the application of the Metaverse in the medical field under the background of the normalization of the epidemic, this paper studied the development status of the Metaverse in the medical field and its application advantages through the literature method, and finds that the development of the Metaverse shows two trends: on the one hand, it is from real to virtual, to realize the digitization of real experience, on the other hand, from virtual to real, to realize the realization of digital experience, through the perfect connection between virtual and reality, will create the next new era of medical information interconnection. The immersive environment of the Metaverse world and the integration of virtual and real space and the characteristics of hyper-simulation plays an important role in realizing disease visualization, famous doctors, psychotherapy scenarios, and innovative pension models. Based on the research and judgment of the advantages of the Metaverse in the medical field, the scenarios or paths of the Metaverse in medical applications are mainly reflected in five aspects: clinical surgery, medical robots, medical teaching, drug and medical device research and development, and AI super doctors.

1 Introduction

The traditional medical model faces the outstanding challenge of the imbalance between supply and demand, and under the challenge of the normalization of the new crown epidemic, the future Metaverse is expected to reconstruct the medical system to achieve the development vision of universal health. Through the analysis of the development status of the medical field in China and the analysis of the concept and characteristics of the Metaverse, this paper analyzes the natural advantages of the Metaverse introducing the medical field, and explores the application of the Metaverse in the medical field.

2 Medical Development Status

At present, the contradiction between supply and demand of China's traditional medical model is prominent. On the one hand, although the supply of medical resources has made great progress compared with the past, there is still a big gap compared with developed countries, which is mainly manifested in insufficient investment in medical funds, poor quality of medical services, and low efficiency of the medical system, which makes it difficult for China's medical system to meet the growing medical needs of our people. In addition, the normalization of the global new crown virus epidemic has put forward new requirements for people's daily life and work styles, the focus of medical and health undertakings, and the conceptual change of government-related work.

2.1 The Short Board of Medical Resource Supply is Obvious

2.1.1 Medical Capital Investment has not Maintained a Synchronous Increase with Fiscal Revenue

According to the "2021 Statistical Bulletin on the Development of China's Health and Health Undertakings", the total national health expenditure in 2021 is estimated to be 7,559.36 billion yuan, of which: the government health expenditure is 2,071.85 billion yuan, accounting for 27.4%; Social health expenditure was 3,392.03 billion yuan, accounting for 44.9%; Personal health expenditure was 2,095.48 billion yuan, accounting for 27.7%. The total per capital expenditure on health is 5348.1 yuan, and the total expenditure on health accounts for 6.5% of GDP. China's medical and health resources, whether in terms of total amount or per capital, still have a big gap compared with developed countries, and health development lags behind economic development. Since 1995, the Chinese government's health budget has grown at an average annual rate of 14.2 percent, compared with 17.5 percent for government revenue over the same period. Social investment has not kept pace with government revenues.

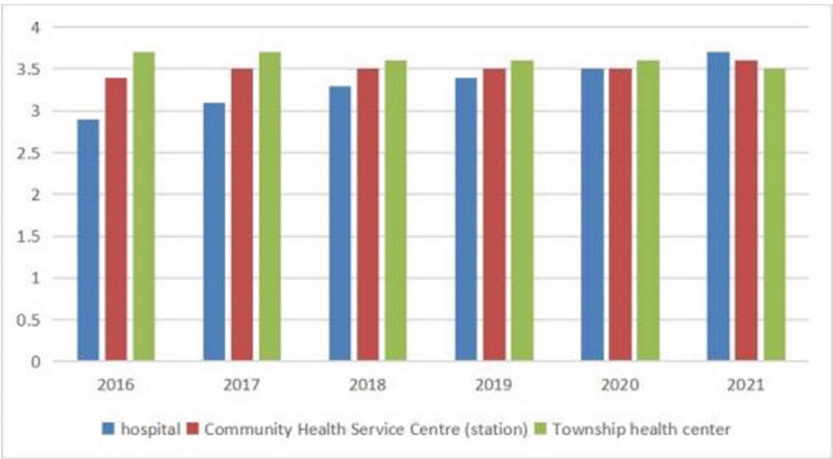


Fig. 1. Number of hospitals, community health service centers (stations) and township health centers in China (unit: 10,000)

By the end of 2021, the total number of medical and health institutions in the country 1030935, an increase of 8,013 over the previous year. Among them, there are 36,570

hospitals, 977,790 primary medical and health institutions, and 13,276 professional public health institutions (Fig. 1).

There are 9.448 million beds in medical and health institutions nationwide, including 7.413 million in hospitals (78.5%), 1.712 million in primary medical and health institutions (18.1%), and 302,000 in professional public health institutions (3.2%).

From the overall point of view, the irrational distribution of medical resources in China still exists, and the top three hospitals with higher grades have high-quality medical services and management, medical quality and medical efficiency, and can continuously absorb high-quality doctors, high-quality cooperation platforms and other high-quality resources, and the popularity brought by this further attracts a large number of patients to come to seek medical treatment, so the siphon effect leads to patients getting together, the gap between urban and rural medical resources and services is large, and the sinking of resources is facing resistance.

2.1.2 The Quality of Medical and Health Resources Needs to be Improved

By the end of 2021, the total number of health personnel in the country was 13.983 million, an increase of 508,000 over the previous year (an increase of 3.8%). Among them, there are 11.242 million health technicians. Among the health technicians, there are 4.287 million practicing (assistant) physicians and 5.018 million registered nurses.

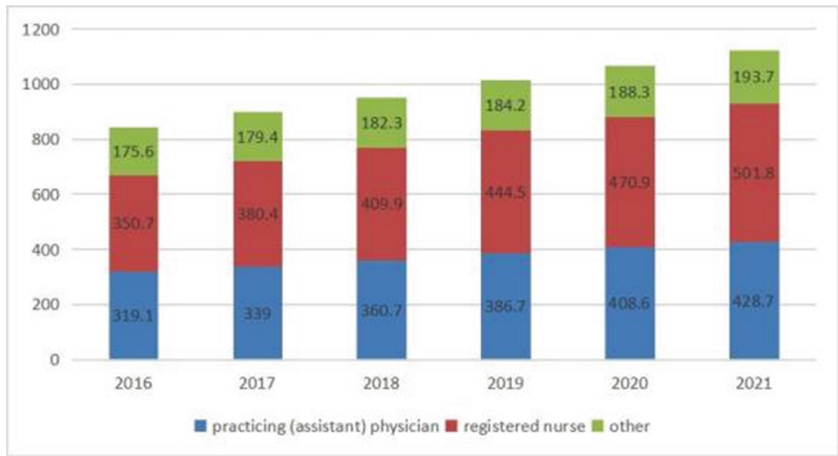


Fig. 2. Number of health technicians in the country (unit: 10,000 people)

According to the “National Medical and Health Service System Planning Outline (2015—2020)”, the number of practicing (assistant) physicians, nurses and beds per 1,000 population is relatively low. Among practicing (assistant) physicians, only 45% have a bachelor’s degree or above; Among the registered nurses, only 10% have a bachelor’s degree or above. At the same time, from the perspective of the high-end medical device market, especially the third-class hospitals in first- and second-tier cities,

foreign capital accounts for the vast majority of the proportion, and even reaches more than 90% (Fig. 2).

2.2 The Demand for Medical Resources from Our People is Increasing day by day

In recent years, with the improvement of per capita income and people’s health awareness, people have paid more attention to the prevention of diseases, which has brought about the growing rigid demand of the medical industry.

2.2.1 Increase in Population Ageing

With the advancement of medical technology, the average life expectancy of the global population continues to increase, which also brings about the problem of population aging that cannot be ignored. The number of people over the age of 65 in China has increased from 130 million in 2013 to 190 million in 2020, and the proportion of the total population has also increased from 9.7% to 13.5%, from the total amount and relative quantity, the growth trend is extremely obvious, and China’s aging problem is intensifying, becoming a social problem that has to be faced.

2.2.2 High Incidence of Intractable Diseases such as Cancer

Due to the increasing complexity of the current human living environment, the incidence of intractable diseases such as cancer has generally increased. In 2015, there were 4 million new cases of cancer in China, and by 2020, the number has reached 4.6 million, and it is expected to grow to 5.2 million by 2025.

2.2.3 Growing Demand for Chronic Diseases and Rehabilitation

With the continuous improvement of the people's living standards since the beginning of reform and opening up, especially after experiencing the rapid economic development of our country in this century, the people's dietary structure has also undergone major changes. Long-term unhealthy eating habits have spawned chronic diseases such as hypertension and diabetes, and the number of patients is rising year by year, and it is expected that by 2024, the number of people with hypertension and diabetes will reach 380 million and 130 million, respectively, and the resulting demand for treatment and rehabilitation will also increase significantly.

2.3 The Normalization of the New Crown Epidemic Has Put Forward New Requirements for Medical and Health Undertakings

First, The focus of medical and health undertakings needs to gradually shift from the traditional "treatment of diseases and saving people" to "health care and strengthening the body", emphasizing the health literacy of residents, going back to "treating diseases before they occur", and fully studying medical methods to improve human immunity and resistance;

Second, living and behavior habits will be changed greatly. Wearing masks, shopping online, reducing social gatherings, and contactless takeaways will become routine. Health care services should actively respond to changes in people's living, working styles and habits, and update service content and service methods;

Third, the concept of health needs to be systematically and comprehensively integrated into the various plans of social governance and management, and the goal of universal health should be incorporated into various public policies. This also puts forward requirements for the change of the concept of government public management, including public utilities such as medical and health services.

3 The Concept and Characteristics of the Medical Metaverse

3.1 The Concept of the Medical Metaverse

Currently, there are different definitions of the Metaverse. Through the literature method, the author concludes that the Metaverse is a high-level form of the Internet, a comprehensive platform for creation, trading, socialization, entertainment, and display, and a perfect channel connecting online and offline. 3.2.2 Open Creation and Communication

In the medical Metaverse space, each user can freely enter the space at any place and time to create social relations and scenes that meet their own needs, and the communication scenario will also revolve around the user itself, which is a decentralized and near-equal communication pattern. At the same time, medical Metaverse users can also carry out various social activities between doctors and patients, patients and doctors in the space of the Metaverse, which not only achieves the real social and emotional experience provided by panoramic social perception, but also hopes to form a safer and more harmonious doctor-patient relationship. The visualization and visualization of medical terms can greatly improve the patient’s cognition and understanding of the disease, and achieve synchronous and effective real-time communication.

3.2.3 Intelligent Digital Collections

Relying on digital technologies such as artificial intelligence, Blockchain, MR and the Internet of things, Metaverse includes cyberspace, big data world and virtual reality world, and is a collection of intelligent digital technologies. And with the continuous expansion of the Metaverse technology collection, more advanced technologies and innovative applications will also be added to the service scope of the medical meta-universe.

3.2.4 Online and Offline Integration

The deep integration of virtualization and real in the Metaverse forms an online and offline integration relationship, and the boundary between virtual and reality in the Metaverse space will no longer be clear, and individuals will exist in an online form, in

which various life and social activities will be carried out to meet their offline needs. The emergence of the medical Metaverse will promote the comprehensive integration of online and offline and form a new type of social relationship. Online medical consultation + general practitioners come to the door, online user personalized data + daily life care robots and other online and offline combination punches, which are of great practical significance for the elderly, especially the single elderly, in their life, and can ensure their basic social needs and learning and life needs.

4 The Current Status of the Metaverse in the Field of Medicine

4.1 New Technologies is Rich in Various Applications in the Medical Field

On one hand, new technologies in the Metaverse field such as VR virtual reality and AR augmented reality are being used more in the medical industry. This includes early CAdE (Computer-assisted detection) computer-aided testing, which can effectively reduce the rate of missed diagnoses in clinical care; There is also CADx (Computer-assisted diagnosis) computer-aided diagnosis, which can also greatly reduce the rate of misdiagnosis. Based on the application of Metaverse technology such as AI artificial intelligence, intelligent detection, intelligent classification, and intelligent segmentation of images can be carried out, and auxiliary diagnosis solutions can be provided through multi-modal information fusion big data analysis, which helps to greatly improve the accuracy of diagnosis and achieve precision medicine.

4.2 The Era of Imaging Big Data Promotes Changes in the Medical Field

With the continuous growth of people's demand for medical treatment, the current demand for image detection has doubled, and the number of image detection has increased year by year, resulting not only bringing a large demand for detection equipment, but also bringing great challenges to the data storage equipment, a CT examination will acquire more than 6,000 images, a patient may also do a variety of examinations, after each film to transfer all the data to the server, and finally to the storage device. These processes will bring massive amounts of data, and these processes occur all the time in the hospital, this "era of image big data" puts forward high requirements for storage devices.

In the era of imaging big data, all kinds of medical images are stored in PACS, all kinds of clinical information is stored in HIS, all kinds of examination and test information are stored in LIS, and the preservation requirements of these data are long-term retention

of online for three years and offline for three years. According to the available data, the current annual growth rate of medical imaging data in the United States is 63.1%, and the annual growth rate of radiologists is only 2.2%, a gap of 60.9%; The annual growth rate of imaging data in China is 30%, and the annual growth rate of radiologists is 4.1%, and the gap is 23.9%. Therefore, relying only on the doctor's human eye to observe the huge image is facing a huge challenge, which brings huge development space to the Metaverse technology represented by AI artificial intelligence.

4.3 Human-Machine Integration Constantly Developed in the Medical Metaverse

The medical field is suitable for the application of human-machine integration, and also promotes its further development. At present, human-machine integration has gone through two main stages in medical applications. The first stage is the traditional CAD computer-aided detection, which requires doctors to manually input images, extract features, classify, and then the computer will automatically output the results, which is inefficient and easy to "slip through the net". Based on this, the current human-computer integration has developed to the second stage, which not only creates a CAD technology based on deep learning, which is to build a deep, integrated network that simulates the human brain, automatically extracts essential features and outputs final results, and improves the accuracy of detection and diagnosis.

The rapid development of emerging technologies represented by information technology and artificial intelligence has greatly expanded the scope of time, space and people's cognition, and mankind is entering an era of intelligent interconnection of all things with the three-way integration of "human-machine-organism". As a typical scene in the era of "human-machine-organism" three-dimensional integration, medical and technology practitioners are further promoting the scientific theory, technical viewpoint and development system of virtual-real interaction, human-machine collaboration and the emergence of group wisdom, including Metaverse and human-computer integration, which will become an important carrier for accelerating the construction of a healthy China and realizing a healthy economy, and will also be the best testing ground for artificial intelligence technology.

5 The Natural Advantages of the Metaverse in the Medical Field

Metaverse provides a data basis for the comprehensive improvement of human health by comprehensively monitoring human microbiology, nutrition, psychology and other higher-level vital sign indicators, thereby finding biological targets for the health intervention, which is of vital importance to the development of the medical industry. The "Healthy China 2030 Planning Outline" proposes to comprehensively improve national health, which is consistent with the ultimate goal of the medical Metaverse to "cure the disease", so the Metaverse has a natural advantage in the medical field.

5.1 Visualize the Symptoms

CT, DR, MRI and all other imaging equipment, the goal is to visualize the disease, because the organ is inside the human body, is invisible, so the goal of the first generation

of medical devices is to visualize what is invisible. For example, lung nodule localization and three-dimensional visualization technology, through medical devices to take out a piece of internal sliced images, so that “invisible” human organs “appear in their original form”, and even build a holographic digital person, providing a reference for surgical planning.

5.2 Professional Doctor Widely Available

TeleMedicine and graded diagnosis and treatment can increase the inclusiveness of expert resources. For example, the First Affiliated Hospital of Zhengzhou University is known as the world’s largest hospital, doctors are very tired and hard every day, how to extend the ability of doctors in large hospitals to the grassroots, which can use the power of new technologies such as Metaverse and AI to promote remote diagnosis and treatment, so that more patients do not have to go to the provincial city to see a doctor, get professional diagnosis and treatment at the doorstep of the family, and achieve “difficult empowerment, good and great”.

5.3 Realize the Scenario of Psychological Diagnosis and Treatment

Most psychological problems actually stem from ineffective thinking, trapped in their own hypothetical situations and derived from stress. The general treatment method is similar to the case reorganization, allowing the patient to assume a situational role in the imagination, and the doctor guides the patient to make psychological relief. In the Metaverse, doctors can put the patient directly in it through virtual scenes, and the immersion and privacy of the Metaverse makes it easier for patients to focus, which can reduce the patient’s failure to imagine or recall the past and other factors to affect the efficacy, while greatly shortening the time required for treatment. Virtual scenes can also create environmentally assistive therapies such as unethical, illegal or dangerous in real life. At the same time, psychological diagnosis and treatment in the Metaverse can break the cultural barriers and stigma labels between doctors and patients, so that patients can reduce their resistance to medical treatment, and it is easier to establish mutual relations with doctors.

5.4 Boost the Innovation of the Pension Model

With the arrival of China’s retirement peak after 2022, the impact of the one-child policy over 30 years will make it difficult to continue the traditional pension model, both the country and the families will face the dual dilemma of pension.

Metaverse uses technologies such as speech recognition, intelligent control, inter-connection of all things and virtual digital people to carry out old-age services, which will help solve the lack of energy and physical strength of the elderly people, ensure the safety of the elderly people at home, and reduce the occurrence of accidents; Big data technology produces digital identity numbers and identity QR codes for the elderly, combined with face recognition technology, to facilitate travel, medical treatment and social networking for the elderly; VR three-dimensional three-dimensional information

service platform for the elderly, through the virtual scene method, so that the elderly can go shopping online without leaving home. Pension enterprises will fully present the service content in a virtual digital way, the elderly people can accurately choose the pension service that suits them through on-site immersive feelings. Platform pension enterprises are managed through the blockchain, open and transparent, to prevent the elderly from being deceived. Online work can support the secondary employment and entrepreneurship of the young and healthy elderly people, help to update their knowledge for free, let the elderly have something to do, the country, enterprises, individuals win-win.

6 Metaverse Application Scenarios in the Medical Industry

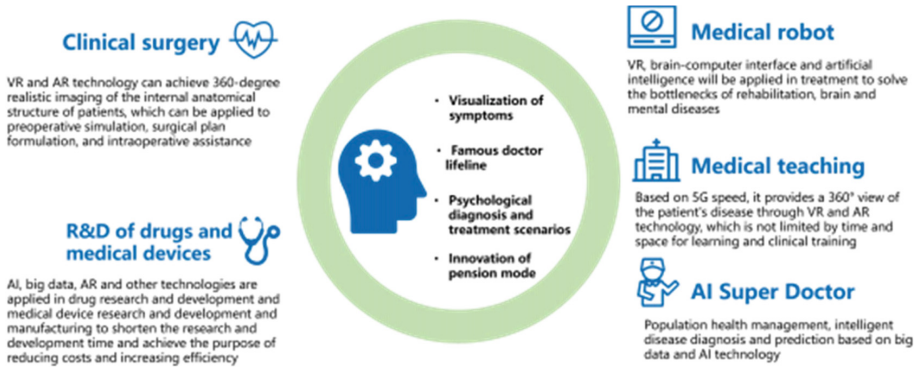


Fig. 3. Schematic of the medical application scenario of the Metaverse

Based on the advantages of meta-universe medical applications, this paper believes that meta-universe medical application scenarios or paths mainly include and are not limited to the following aspects (Fig. 3).

6.1 Clinical Surgery

360-degree realistic imaging of patients' internal anatomy is realized through VR and AR technology, which is applied to preoperative simulation, surgical plan formulation, intraoperative assistance, etc. In the existing clinical surgical practice, there are problems such as the accuracy and safety of surgery, the limitation of medical surgical resources and poor communication between doctors and patients, etc. Metaverse element can be applied to the entire process from preoperative clinical surgery to intraoperative clinical surgery, through VR/AR, hologram and other technologies, to solve the difficulty of surgical lesion positioning, the shortage of medical surgical resources and poor communication between doctors and patients, etc. Its key application scenarios are reflected in the formulation of surgical plans and preoperative simulation, doctor-patient communication, intraoperative real-time imaging, intraoperative operation assistance and remote surgery.

For example, Vicarious Surgical's surgical machine in the United States can enter the abdominal cavity through a single incision of 1.5 cm or even smaller, providing a 360-degree full view, and the doctor obtains a panoramic sense of realism by wearing VR glasses and joysticks, as if entering the patient's abdominal cavity; Augmediics' Surgical Visualization AR system in Israel can provide doctors with "X-ray vision" in complex surgeries, indicating the location of surgical instruments in real time and correctly, allowing the surgeon to perform surgery even without looking at the monitor and without leaving the patient's eyes.

6.2 Medical Robots

VR, brain-computer interface, and artificial intelligence are applied to treatment to solve bottlenecks such as rehabilitation, brain and mental illness. The bottleneck of the existing brain and mental illness treatment is reflected in the lack of effective treatment of brain and nerve diseases, the clinical rehabilitation environment has limitations and other difficulties, and the application of medical robots, through the use of VR technology rehabilitation system to build a virtual environment platform, designs virtual rehabilitation training scenarios and medical operation tasks for patients, so that patients can use the virtual environment to generate a sense of presence, improve the enthusiasm of patients to invest in rehabilitation medical treatment, and combine rehabilitation training, psychological treatment and case database management into one.

In addition, it can also realize the exchange of information between the brain and the device by connecting the brain and external devices, and make the brain produce specific sensations through accurate current stimulation, which can be applied to brain/nerve-related diseases such as epilepsy, paralysis, aphasia, stroke rehabilitation, etc. For example, XR Health, a long distance care company in the United States, combines VR headsets with immersive technology to allow patients to undergo rehabilitation training at home, covering sports injuries, pain management, stress management, menopause, stroke rehabilitation, memory training, and traumatic brain injury rehabilitation.

6.3 Medical Teaching

Based on 5G speed, it provides a 360-degree view of the patient's disease through VR and AR technology, and is not limited by time and space for learning and clinical training. At present, there are pain points in medical teaching in terms of teaching scenarios are not realistic enough, medical anatomy physical specimen donors are insufficient, geography and case limitations, etc., Metaverse elements can be applied to enhance teaching of medical training, anatomy teaching and digital medicine library construction to solve the above problems.

For example, Oculus helmet technology is applied to the University of Connecticut Medical Center Plastic Surgery Residency Training, where doctors can see a series of surgical demonstrations in 3D images, have the opportunity to do it themselves, trial and error, and get immediate feedback from teachers; THE VR surgery training and simulation program provided by OSSO VR Company reproduces the operating room scene through highly realistic visual technology, allowing users to exercise the actual operation of various types of surgeries in a virtual environment through VR remote

control devices; Allow surgeons to interact with new medical devices in a 3D space, increasing user familiarity with medical device companies' new solutions.

6.4 Drug and Medical Device Research and Development

AI, big data, AR and other technologies are applied to drug research and development and medical device research and development and manufacturing, shortening the research and development time and achieving the purpose of reducing costs and increasing efficiency. In the face of the current pain points in drug research and development and medical device development and manufacturing, Metaverse elements can solve the high cost of drug research and development, long research and development cycle, low success rate, and high precision requirements in medical device research and development.

For example, Exscientia has built three technology modules¹ and formed a complete end-to-end AI solution from target selection to patient selection, with four major tasks: target selection, designing the right candidate molecules, collecting the right data, and selecting the right patients; Alva systems apply AR to medical device manufacturing, which can help realize the inspection of medical equipment production lines and equipment production lines, and realize the visualization of digital twin IoT of production lines; Inspectors use a variety of mobile terminals such as AR glasses, mobile phones and tablets to three-dimensionally see the operating status and parameter values of the overall equipment, support gestures and voice commands to adjust the parameter display content, and greatly improve the inspection efficiency and accuracy.

6.5 AI Super Doctor

Based on big data and AI technology for population health management, intelligent diagnosis and prediction of diseases, AI super doctors can be applied to auxiliary diagnosis, health management and the disease prediction in view of the shortage of medical resources in China, the uneven level of medical technology and the pressure of cost control. For example, Evidation Health has teamed up with top pharmaceutical companies to advance exploratory research, such as Eli Lilly exploring the uses of smart device data to detect cognitive decline and mild Alzheimer's disease; 3-year collaboration with Sanofi to monitor daily living behaviors and health management for people with type 2 diabetes; Qure.ai use deep learning technology to interpret medical images, screen for a variety of infectious and non-communicable diseases, and recommend personalized treatment options.

Although the development of the Metaverse is still in its infancy, it is expected to mature in the next decade with the cultivation of related technologies such as 5G, cloud computing, XR and ecosystems. At present, the application of Metaverse elements in various fields of health care has begun to take shape, and in the future, with the maturity of technology and capital investment, as well as the transformation of the normalization of the epidemic on the overall pattern of medical undertakings, the medical Metaverse will closely focus on the patient experience, actively innovate medical service content and service methods, establish an effective connection between reality and virtual integration,

online and offline integration, and promote the realization of the grand vision of national health.

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Cyberpunk and Cypherpunk: A Philosophical Analysis Comparing Two Views of the Metaverse

Abstract. As ancestors of the idea of the metaverse - Cyberpunks and Cypherpunks - propose two distinct attitudes towards Cyberspace, and this difference also infuses their attitudes towards the metaverse. These two attitudes will powerfully influence the developmental direction of the metaverse and how it will be recognized and accepted by society. Given that the visual space is an artificial reality created by technology, they not only illustrate two different ideas regarding “realities other than the physical one of human society”, but also illustrate two different ideas regarding technology itself. The Cyberpunk view of the metaverse could be seen as techno-pessimistic or Luddism. Cypherpunk’s metaverse view, on the other hand, is “technological transformationism”, which carries multi-possibilities of living styles of human being, and it almost incompatible with Luddism.

Keywords: Metaverse · Cyberpunk · Cypherpunk · Philosophy of technology

1 Introduction

The metaverse rose to prominence in 2021. It has become a pan-cultural phenomenon that sparks commentary and participation from a wide range of disciplines and industries. Corresponding to this is the uncertainty regarding its conceptual definition, technological standards, and evaluation methods. In other words, it is still difficult for us to get a precise unified consensus on the concept of the metaverse. Aside from the business and financial applications, I find two methods for evaluating the metaverse with partial consensus, which can be described as two views. Respectively, they correspond to virtual reality and internet technology with blockchain as the core. These two technological directions are also related to two similarly-pronounced concepts, namely “Cyberpunk” and “Cypherpunk”. Historically, they have rarely been related to each other, and it is precisely the unified concept of the metaverse that has contributed to their rivalry.

The focus of this article is to analyze and compare views of metaverses from the perspectives of Cyberpunk and Cypherpunk. They happen to be related to two different attitudes toward the relationship between metaverse and the real world. The original ideal metaverse comes from Neil Stephen’s cyberpunk novel “Snow Crash” [1]. These two attitudes will develop into different directions of investigation on the authenticity of “virtual cyberspace”. When we examine whether the “virtual” should compromise with “reality”, we will find that versions of the metaverse supported by different philosophical views of technology will take different paths.

2 Snow Crash and the Inappropriately Implemented Metaverse

Although there are different opinions on the technological standards and development direction of the metaverse, there is a consensus on the starting point of the concept itself. It originated in the novel “Snow Crash”, and swept the world with Spielberg’s film “Ready Player One”, which duplicated the former’s setting. For convenience of organisation, we will introduce the “metaverse” as imagined in “Snow Crash” as if divided into two parts: 1. The part which overlaps with the metaverse that has been realized or is expected to be realized currently; 2. The part that is different from the metaverse in the real world at the moment.

The concept of virtual reality (VR) was first proposed in “Snow Crash”. However, the construction of the metaverse in our world requires not only VR technology but also a 3D modeling engine and a digital world physical construction system that can create a sense of “real” immersion. Although imperfect, these technologies have entered the stage of usability. Examples include the Oculus Quest 2, Unreal Engine 5, and the Omniverse virtual work platform are standouts in their respective fields. Based on the accumulation of technology, some companies with strong resources such as Meta (Facebook), Tencent, etc. have launched metaverse projects, which are committed to reconstructing the virtual environment for the office, education, social interaction, and entertainment.

In addition, the metaverse in “Snow Crash” is also a Sandbox game with a high degree of freedom, in which players can own and build virtual land and upload programs. In this game, metaverse regions would look very different due to the variety of tastes and technological abilities of players. A connected concept is User Generated Content (UGC). Namely, users create content, and the central platform only provides the basic framework. The “Warcraft map editor”, and MOD production in “The Elder Scrolls” and “Mount and Blade” represent UGC. It is more thorough in “Second Life”, Minecraft and Roblox with the independent production of virtual avatars by users of “Second Life” directly inheriting the story settings and plots in “Snow Crash”. But these are not enough to construct a ideal metaverse, because users can not own their digital assets, without being manipulated by these companies.

The metaverse in “Snow Crash” is a highly decentralized network. There is no system administrator or backdoor system for manipulation, which means no super-system authority. It is a paradise for hackers and programmers. This makes it more like the Internet than a local system. Roblox and Sandbox which claim to be metaverse are not strictly decentralized enough (and Meta’s Horizon Workroom is simply centralized). They may be metaverse-like in some respects, but the underlying technological logic has not yet reached the ideal standard. There are two reasons: 1. They have not been able to completely get rid of the traditional smart contract (computer program-based business or other human-machine/human interaction with value); 2. Some their network infrastructure (such as storage) is still centralized.

According to Nick Szabo (a cypherpunk) [2], traditional smart contracts (a centralized smart contract, such as a common buying and selling program on the vending machine) generally require a backdoor system. Such smart contracts require a “third party” to act as an intermediary to provide arbitration or deliberation for interactions between users in a system. Decentralized smart contracts need to be built on a public blockchain. Blockchain technology enables the confirmation of business communication

interactions. It also enables part of the delivery work to be distributed to automated programs based on hashing, signatures and specific consensus mechanism of distributed protocols. Ethereum is currently the most successful blockchain in the industry that deploys smart contracts. Developers build their smart contracts and decentralized applications on Ethereum through the Ethereum Virtual Machine.

But this is not enough. Although some metaverse projects like Sandbox are based on Ethereum in terms of value circulation and virtual property confirmation, ultimate control of the game operation is still in the hands of the developers. The real metaverse would never go offline and would have no access restrictions. At the same time, its software updates would not depend on any institution or individual and must be the result of the users' group resolution. It is difficult for commercial projects to include these characteristics.

Such a metaverse is a large decentralized virtual world, and building it requires upgrading of the internet infrastructure. For example, it requires the reconstruction of the underlying protocols of the Internet to establish a set of P2P storage protocols that can be used to distribute and store large-scale dynamic data. Projects such as the Interplanetary File System (IPFS) and Arweave are working in this direction. Only when the decentralized infrastructure is completed will the metaverse – like the internet - never go offline.

From Meta to Tencent, from Roblox to Sandbox, the current metaverse projects on the market do not fully conform to the idea of the “Metaverse”. They may have elements of it in some respects, but not enough for realizing the kind of metaverse imagined in Snow Crash. The two perspectives discussed in this article are related to this. Cyberpunk-style metaverse reviews, which focus on deviations of the metaverse from the reality of human society, often focus on the overlap of the current metaverse (VR technology) and that seen in Snow Crash; while Cypherpunk's expectations for the metaverse (an ultimate decentralized one) are based on the difference between it and the Snow Crash metaverse (they worry that its realizations are not decentralized enough).

3 Cyberpunk's Warning

From 2021 to the present, the metaverse has been reviewed endlessly. Most of these comments are related to keywords like “dystopia”, “capital control”, etc. These cyberpunk reviews warn of blind technological optimism and technological determinism, and also examine the negative effects of capital and power control in the process of social evolution brought about by technology. These dystopian stories take place in cyberspace. Among the classic movies, “Akira” (1998) directed by Katsuhiro Otomo, and “Ghost in the Shell” (1995) by Mamoru Oshii are typical cyberpunk arts.

The point about “immersive spaces built with virtual reality are not worth looking forward to” is one of the most frequent criticisms. The founder of the mobile game Pokémon GO, John Hanke [3], wrote “The metaverse is a dystopian nightmare, Let's build a better reality”. Commenting on the VR metaverse, he also said: What if technology could make us better? Could it nudge us to get off the couch and out for an evening stroll or a Saturday in the park? Could it draw us into public space and into contact with neighbors we might never have met? Could it give us a reason to call a friend, make plans with our

families, or even discover brand-new friends? Collectively, could it help us discover the magic, history, and beauty hiding in plain sight?" Hanke's subtext is that the metaverse has taken us away from real life and reduced real human interpersonal-contact. We can see a similar warning in the film "Surrogates".

Hanke was just emphasizing the importance of the real world to human life, while another strand of cyberpunk metaverse commentary is more serious and philosophical. It review argues that the metaverse will pull humanity back into "Plato's cave" - into an inextricable fantasy. Philosopher Nozick constructed a thought experiment similar to the "Matrix" in his "Anarchy, State and Utopia" [4]: In it, people can knowingly choose to be in a container with electronic interfaces in their brains. By stimulating his brain, the best neuropsychologists provide him with whatever experience he desires. Nozick puts forward three reasons for rejecting the experience machine: 1. I want to do some (real) things, not just get the experience of doing these things; 2. For a person living in a container, there is no meaning in life, "it's the same as suicide"; 3. The experience machine cannot give the users anything more profound than the artificial virtual environment.

Nozick exhibits a social reality-centric approach, which we may call "physical reality-centrism". For him, the anchor point of value must be based on real society, and virtual reality is either "unreal" or just "second-class reality". The former heralds a kind of perception-centrism (such as Berkeley's "To exist is to be perceived"), while the latter still acknowledges the reality of the virtual environment, but does not value it. Neither of them expresses distrust of the maturity of the technology, but only of the technology itself.

However, perception-centrism is not suitable for providing a theoretical description of VR. David Chalmers [5] assumes that VR is an experience constructed by human perception. To him, human perceptions produced by VR are neither hallucination (generated purely by the human brain without external information input) nor illusion (with external – but misleading - information input). Crucially, in the VR environment, people only have a perception after receiving the information input, so it cannot be regarded as a hallucination.

Neither is VR perception an illusion. Chalmers uses an analogy to illustrate this: person (A) enters a restaurant and does not notice a large mirror in front of him. A perceives person B approaching from the opposite direction, but in fact, B approaches from behind him. There are two conditions for this illusion. 1. A does not know that a device that does not reflect the "real" situation is inputting information to him; 2. A still cannot use this device proficiently. Just think about a rearview mirror. We know its existence and purpose, and we can use it skillfully. This situation is not an illusion. A person who has just entered the VR world is likely to have some illusions, which are the same as when we first watch a 3D movie. But if you become an "expert," you don't have this illusion and instead experience real interactions with others in this environment. All in all, it is hard to say that VR is an environment centered on constructing hallucinations and illusions.

Both Chalmers' "Digital Realism" [5] and Zhai Zhenming's "Perceptual Frame Equivalence Principle" [6] are trying to examine whether physical reality and virtual

reality are equally real to human experience. In other words, they both see a virtual environment as a real scenario that provides causal interaction for humans. This response to Nozick is a reason for discounting his first objection. But his second objection must still be examined: can this virtual reality provide us with a meaningful life? Zhenming believes: “The difference of meaning is first related to the initial intention. This intention determines what kind of real changes the selected part (a constituent) of the object world should have (from the subject of intentional movement), and these changes does not reveal as the experience of human being, but rather the changes of reality. The concept of success versus the concept of failure is originally about individual intentions, the concept of ownership is about the collective institutionalized intention of all individual participants, and the concept of moral responsibility is about the interaction between all individuals and the collective institutionalized intention “ [6]. That is, as long as the actor can cause real objects to change in the VR world, this intentionality is real. Furthermore meaningful value concepts such as rights, success, and morality can be reduced to intentional relationships. Therefore, the VR world has the power to construct meaning.

In the end, only Nozick’s third objection remains. Chalmers argues that this objection expresses a distrust of the artificial environment. But in this case, it shouldn’t be just VR technology that is mistrusted: tech artifacts of the physical real world should not be trusted either. Chalmers appears to be suggesting a “Luddite” attitude towards VR technology (i.e. opposition to technological progress). The original Luddite workers who smashed machines were not opposed to all technology, but only the part of it that they could not adapt to. VR opponents don’t have to reject all technological artificial environments, they just need to believe that the reality that VR constructs “doesn’t feel right.” They can indeed identify many metaverse problems, such as “what if there is a bug in the system?”; “VR will cause dizziness, will it be harmful to the human body?”; “what if these technologies are used to control society?”, and many more. However, it is theoretically consistent for them to be completely techno-pessimistic – because real-world technology also has negative effects on human society.

“Luddism” is different from outright techno-pessimism. The latter cannot theoretically reach a compromise with the metaverse, while the former can. Metaverse developers just need to develop some applications that don’t make people uncomfortable. For example, as John Hanke said since human beings need a real-world communication environment, the metaverse might as well abandon VR and use Augmented Reality (AR), mixed reality (XR) and IoT technologies. However, will a metaverse that compromises with physical reality succeed? Holders of another view of the metaverse – the Cypherpunks – don’t think so. In their view, cyberspace constructed by another important technology of the metaverse – internet technology – cannot compromise with the real world. Once humans try to do so, they are likely to get neither the benefits of the real world nor the benefits of the cyber world.

4 The Metaverse in the Eyes of Cypherpunk

The original “cypherpunks” were a group of privacy-protecting activists who emerged in the 1990s and advocated the idea of establishing the use of unregulated encryption technology in the United States [7]. Without such technologies there would be

no contemporary-style internet or metaverse infrastructure. Blockchain, cryptocurrency technology, and the technological implementation of distributed systems have been influenced a lot by Cypherpunk and internet libertarian movements. In a narrow sense, Cypherpunks are cryptographers, engineers, and tech geeks who communicate with each other via email groups. The earliest Cypherpunk group was established in 1992 by Eric Hughes, Timothy C. May, and John Gilmore, and the name Cypherpunk was created by Jude Milton, inspired by the concept of “cyberpunk”.

There are three notable concepts within early Cypherpunk: 1. The emphasis on privacy protection; 2. “Cypherpunk writes code”; and 3. The proposal of cryptocurrency. Eric Hughes states in the “Cypherpunk Manifesto” that privacy is different from secrecy. Privacy refers to information that the owner does not want the world to know (such as personal information), while secrecy refers to information that the owner does not want anyone else to know (such as a bank password). Privacy protection means that people can choose to expose only the necessary information (such as transaction information) in online interactions [8]. In the 1990s, there were no institutions in the United States that actively protected people’s privacy, so Cypherpunks advocated the use of encryption technology, private mail, digital signatures, and encrypted currency to protect confidentiality by writing their own code and building open-source software. Hughes’ understanding of privacy and how to protect it bodes well for the difference between the internet (the cyber world where the metaverse resides) and the real world. To be precise, what Cypherpunk maintains is precisely those characteristics of the internet that are different from the real world.

In addition, we need to think about what conclusions can be drawn when understanding regulatory issues in the context of this difference. “Cypherpunk writes code” shows an autonomous regulation scheme that is unique to the internet. At the same time, we also need to explore the technological philosophical presupposition behind it – the incorporation of value and technology, and cryptocurrency represented by Bitcoin is the concentrated expression of this view on technology.

Lawrence Lessig [9] stated that cyberspace is different from physical space, leading to the alienation of cyber legal regulation. These differences can be summarized in three points. 1. The inhabitants of the internet are born with the right to design code, which is similar to the ability to formulate the laws of nature in the real world. 2. The special “non-locality” in the online world does not directly correspond to the real world. 3. The concept of public and private in the online world is different from that in real society.

Firstly, let’s look at an example from Lessig: the story of how “Dank’s dog died after eating poisonous flower petals floating over from Martha’s yard” [9]. Dank asks Martha to stop growing the plant, but the paradox is that if Martha stops growing the plant, she loses money, and it is her legal right to grow it in her yard. Dank says irrationally, “Why not make the petals poisonous only when in the possession of someone who has ‘purchased’ them? If they are stolen, or if they blow away, then let the petals lose their poison. But when kept by the owner of the plant, the petals keep their poison. Isn’t that a solution to the problem that both of us face?”.

The law naturally has a way to solve the problem between Martha and Dank in the real world, but it seems difficult to meet Martha’s demands – which would mean eliminating the “negative externality”. A world without negative externalities is full of

readily available, economic “Pareto improvements”, and cyberspace or the metaverse is thought to have the potential to become such a world. The owner of cyberspace is also the designer, and Dank can use coding to achieve Martha’s request. He can even resurrect his virtual pet dog! Therefore, one observation we make here is that the ideal internet and Metaverse should have a different internal structure to the real world. The internet and the metaverse can provide people with an alternative way of life. But we must also be aware that codes can communicate regulations from physical reality, and humans can make cyberspace a space that resembles physical reality.

The second point is that the non-locality of cyberspace cannot correspond to real space. In the movie “The Matrix”, there is a scene that illustrates this point: the protagonist opens any door to go to another location. This is an image metaphor for cyberspace. It seems that online residents can break the restrictions imposed by physical space on their network avatars. The transformation of life scenarios no longer requires commuting time, and people from different regions can meet in cyberspace easily at will. This asymmetry between the virtual and the real has led to many new phenomena. For example, human beings are moving into the era in which “close neighbors are inferior to netizens”. And the more serious consequences come from the aspect of legal governance, Lessig gave this example of it [9]: In a country called “Boral”, someone set up a gambling website, and law enforcement forced him to shut down the server in his country, but could not prevent the website from continuing to run and people continuing to visit it, because its servers could be set up in other countries. This is related to the non-local characteristics of the internet. When flipping between different life scenarios, netizens only need to change the information port without having to travel mountains and rivers to access the desired positions. To restrict a website, judicial authorities can order internet service providers to block the IP address of this website through legislation or administration. In this way, the non-locality of the network is artificially limited. For real laws to work in cyberspace, what they often need to do is not judicial work, but engineering and technological work in the name of justice—change the framework of cyberspace, and make it suitable for interaction with the physical world, and this means a centralized internet.

Thirdly, the regulation of cyberspace brings up some troubling situations. First and foremost are intellectual property and privacy issues. In Lessig’s view, the purpose of traditional intellectual property law is different from the purpose of private law. Private property is exclusive: if someone else lives in your house, you can’t live it yourself. Intellectual property rights are different. When others look at one of your paintings, it does not prevent you from also viewing the painting, and the dissemination of knowledge is beneficial to the production of knowledge. Therefore, the purpose of intellectual property law is to achieve a certain **balance** between the private rights of property owners, and the dissemination and re-creation of knowledge rather than to protect the permanent exclusivity of property rights. So Lessig said: “Intellectual property rights are a monopoly that the state gives to producers of intellectual property in exchange for their production of it. After a limited time, the product of their work becomes the public’s to use as it wants.” [9].

This balance was easy to achieve before the creation of the internet because of the high cost of copying intellectual property. Nevertheless, in the internet era, the cost of

copying information is extremely low, and the copying of information is a natural process of activity on the internet. This makes the protection of traditional intellectual property rights impossible to adapt to the Internet. The invalidation of the law has laid the way for people's creations on the Internet from elitism to populism. A culture called remix has arisen (which also prevails in the metaverse). There used to be a creative method called Anime Music Videos (AMWs), by which young people compile excerpts from anime and recomposed music to make videos. In 2015, Wind-up Records instructed an AMWs website to take down all films involving their intellectual property. The case was not legally complicated, but the question was how to completely remove any works related to remix culture. According to Lessig, the only way to fully achieve this is to have a "trust system" that monitors each hard drive for illegal data. The typical method is to store a program in the user's computer, and when it finds that the user has illegal information, it will call the police. But this upsets the balance between copyright holders' rights and free transmission of knowledge, and violates the privacy of users, putting them under the complete control of the Code Law.

The fundamental explanation for this is that the real-world "public-private" division doesn't seem to exist any more on the Internet. The judiciary either controls all networked computers through code (thinking that the Internet is a public domain) or completely ignores it (regarding that the Internet is a private domain). In a centralized Internet, businesses have other ways to protect intellectual property without resorting to overpowering "trust systems." They manage their resources through traditional smart contracts. For example, some movies can be watched for a fee on Youtube. Only when users pay and obtain an electronic certificate can they click to watch these videos. However, with the emergence of the P2P networks, these film and television resources can be obtained for free.

Another solution is Cohen's Law [9], which separates the network account from the real individual, and the network worm engaged in monitoring only knows that "14A" is watching, but does not know who is behind it. It also acknowledges that the web is a purely public sphere, and disconnected from reality. Even if Cohen's Law is used, to achieve intellectual property protection in a centralized network, it is necessary to obtain control over the user's local system and automatically delete or encrypt illegal files, which is not in line with Cypherpunk's demands.

Over the past 20 years, the internet seems to be gradually compromising with or follow the frame of the physical world. The right-to-code construction is gradually assigned to a few monopoly enterprises; the "localization" of the network is becoming more and more important, and users are gradually fixed in specific platform accounts and network areas. However, the "public-private boundary" in the network has never been effectively demarcated and regulated as in the real world (and rebuilding this demarcation seems to be a demand of the metaverse). These phenomena provide targets for the movement of Cypherpunks and their allies. From John Perry Barlow's (1996) "Declaration of Internet Independence" to Richard Stallman's "Free Software Movement", there is no shortage of claims that the rules of the Internet world are different and should not be the same as in the real world. In 2008, the Bitcoin system based on blockchain and cryptography, released by Satoshi Nakamoto, integrated almost all the ideas of internet independentists, which can be summarized as follows:

1. The concept of Cryptocurrency originated from Cypherpunk;
2. The Bitcoin system adopts the operation mode of free software [10], which was first uploaded to the open-source website SourceForge.net by Satoshi Nakamoto (later moved to Github), which is in line with the spirit of “Chpherpunk writing code”;
3. Bitcoin is a p2p network that complies with Cohen’s Law to a certain extent. The transaction data on its chain is public, but it does not correspond to actual personal identities, and it cannot be deleted. This is in line with the privacy-protection spirit of Cypherpunk;
4. The asymmetric encryption system in Bitcoin provides an innovative solution for “public-private division”. The bookkeeper (or miner) in the public network can confirm the transaction, but cannot obtain control of the account. This right belongs only to the user who owns the private key;
5. The control right (accounting right) of the software is not concentrated in the hands of individual nodes, but is distributed in the hands of all those who obtain the right to produce blocks based on the protocol – based on the consensus machnism as proof of work. This is in line with the concept of decentralization of the Internet;
6. The software is a global network, like the internet and there is no access restriction. This is a characteristic of the famous “West Coast Code”, which shows the non-locality of the internet;
7. The “double-spending” attack can be prevented through blockchain technology, thereby offsetting the challenge of “replicative features” to crypto currency, and at the same time, it does not use any real objects or imitated real centralized code identifiers as transaction tokens.

The relationship between Cypherpunk and the metaverse presents itself in two ways. First, the spirit of Cypherpunk and its allies is one of the consensuses among the builders of the metaverse. Secondly, various architectures created by Cypherpunks based on WEB3.0 technologies such as blockchain will become the infrastructure of the metaverse and will be gradually improved. Fred Ehrsam [11], the co-founder of cryptocurrency exchange Coinbase, wrote in 2017 that blockchain can confirm rights over virtual assets (such as avatars) in the metaverse. This is exactly the function of non-fungible tokens (NFTs). An NFT is a virtual token (essentially a smart contract) based on technological models (such as ERC 721, and ERC 1155) on a public chain such as Ethereum, which is non-replaceable data on the blockchain, can be used as a unique identifier, can be traded, and cannot be tampered with or deleted.

NFTs avoid the real world’s reliance on physical objects and consensus to jointly confirm rights, and depends only on blockchain smart contracts and consensus. In addition to NFTs, blockchain-based currency provides an exclusive value token for the metaverse, and the development of decentralized finance, and cross-chain inter-operability also provides a foundation for the flow of value in different metaverse spaces. In addition to relying on blockchain, the current metaverse project also relies heavily on P2P protocol and the fact that internet residents can set up their own platform. At the same time it properly utilizes “replicability”, a central feature of the internet. All of the above points to the difference between the metaverse and the real world. And this difference is created by Cypherpunk’s successors in their contrivance of new technologies.

For Cypherpunks, cyberspace and the Metaverse may not be an ideal paradise. It is more like the rabbit hole in “Alice in Wonderland”. It is full of risks, mistakes, and uncertainties, but it is also compelling, which makes people persistent in their exploration and invention. The adventurous nature of human beings constitutes the premise of this debate.

5 The Metaverse and the Philosophy of Technology

Whether or not to compromise with the physical world is only at the surface of a deeper debate about the nature of the metaverse. There are more profound philosophical explanations to be explored. Let’s look at cyberpunk first. Nozick’s views represent complete technological pessimism, which means technology is capable of self-development: it has its internal developmental logic and is not dependent on human will. From this perspective, people would eventually become vassals of technology, just as people in the experience machine lose the sense of meaning in their existence.

Luddism seems to be compatible with the existence of a technology-neutral theory. It means that technology does not necessarily contain certain values. In the context of the virtual reality problem, the proposition becomes that the metaverse can follow the reality of the physical world. But technological pessimism and Luddism are not completely coincident, because physical reality no longer supplies the adaptive needs of all people.

Let’s look at the philosophical perspective of Cypherpunk. Firstly, Cypherpunks are not techno-neutralists (or techno-optimists), because techno-neutralists believe that the ends and means of technology are only connected by chance. But Cypherpunks and their allies see the internet as a unique space of meaning and endow encryption with a purpose—to protect privacy. So they are not just using the internet and encryption as a tool. Secondly, Cypherpunks are not techno-pessimists either. The practical idea that “cypherpunks write code” is contradictory to the theory of technological autonomy. Then how should the Cypherpunks’ view of technology be understood? The theories of “Transformation by Technology” may help explain (stems from the work of Wu Guosheng[12]). The so-called “transformation” here refers to activating the potentiality of reality, and transforming the philosopher Heidegger’s “being” into “the thing of what it is”. As “being”, the way of life has the potential for innate difference and diversity. Technology is the process that makes this difference a reality. The internet created by Cypherpunk is a kind of “different existence” that is distinct from “real life” and experienced by a representative group of people who realize their lives through their specific technological means.

Technological transformationists will analyze various technologies specifically because different technologies reflect the demands of different groups of people. As a result, the development of a metaverse based on multiple technologies may be divided. But what is more worthy of our attention is whether “anti-technological” technology will appear in the metaverse, if the technology here means the initial way for carrying multiple possibilities of living styles of human being. Before the advent of mechanized clocks, farmers’ time were different due to different lifestyles: technology was determined by life. And the emergence of universal time in industrial society led to a uniformity of people’s ways of life. The experience of human beings may be determined by industrial

technology, but it has perhaps lost a certain type of “meaning”. From this perspective, Cypherpunk’s “entering the rabbit hole” may be counted as an effort to counter a certain uniformity through a different reality produced by different technological framework. The question of whether metaverse follows the domination by reality may be cast differently: whether humanity is compromising with the “anti-technology” philosophy of modern industrial society. Cyberpunks and Cypherpunks seem have distinct attitudes on this point.

6 Conclusion

We can now return to the core metaphor of Stephenson’s “Snow Crash”. The “Snow Crash” in the novel is essentially an information virus that can infect any information carrier, such as genes, languages (mind), or computer code. The infected system will enter a primitive state of disorientation. Language (and information technology) itself is a “technology” created for the “anti-Babel project”, but it is not aimed at destroying the unity of mankind as in the Bible story, but to prevent mankind from returning to a primitive chaotic state and to provide a “vaccine” against the virus. Perhaps it is a coincidence that the “technology” discussed in this article should be the “transformer” that promotes diverse ways of life for human beings, rather than a provider of a uniform and empty “new order”. With this understanding, we also have another interesting perspective to understand why internet geeks who advocate a metaverse model of “multiple” intercommunication do not like monopoly internet giants presenting their metaverse concepts to the market, even though such concepts may be acceptable to Luddites.

The Application of the Metaverse in Ecological Education

Abstract. Ecological education is very practical in global ecological governance and ecological civilization construction. By creating a high - fidelity environmental context, the metaverse ecological education is more likely to stimulate the ecological emotions of the learners, and then transform into a positive ecological behavior, which can effectively make up for the defects of traditional classroom ecological education. The metaverse ecological education is also facing new challenges such as digital monopoly, infringing learners' privacy, and learners addicted easily. Therefore, the meta-verse ecological education should adhere to the basic principles of people - oriented, virtual and real balance, and sustainable. By improving teachers' digital literacy levels, creating a digital learning environment, it actively realizes the meta-verse ecological education. This is not only a realistic requirement for the construction of ecological civilization, but also a new topic facing the development of ecological education.

1 Introduction

In 1992, Neil Stephenson clearly proposed the “Metaverse” in the novel “Avalanche”. It is exactly 30 years since the concept was first proposed. The concept of the metaverse has not yet formed an accurate and consistent definition. The word Metaverse is a portmanteau of the prefix “meta” and the suffix “-verse”. Thus it literally means a universe beyond the physical world [1]. Metaverse is a virtual space parallel to the real world and IS supported by AI, big data, HCI, and other communication technologies [2]. On October 28, 2021, Mark Elliot Zuckerberg, the founder of Facebook, announced that Facebook was renamed “Meta”, and many media also called the “first year of the metaverse” in 2021. In many aspects of human world economy and life, it has become a key area for enterprises and government investment layouts.

The article first pointed out the important role of ecological education in ecological governance and ecological civilization construction, and then analyzed the theoretical feasibility and practical feasibility of the metaverse ecological education. Make up the defects of traditional classroom ecological education, so we should actively explore the feasible path of the metaverse ecological education. However, the metaverse ecological

education is also facing new challenges such as digital monopoly, infringing learners' privacy, and easy addiction. Therefore, on the basis of adhering to the basic principles of people - oriented, virtual reality, and sustainable, the digital learning environment and the development of application pilots to realize the metaverse ecological education, which is not only conducive to the construction of ecological civilization, but also has a profound impact on the development of ecological education in the future.

2 Necessity of Ecological Education

2.1 People Are More and More Concerned About the Quality of the Ecological Environment

The current ecological problems have become the key issues of human attention. Whether it is academic or practical practice, human research on ecological problems attaches great importance to. Because ecological problems itself has the characteristics of cross - boundary, complexity, and long - term nature, ecological problems have become a global issue at home and abroad, and ecological governance has become an important part of global governance. Nowadays, with the improvement of people's living conditions, the status of the ecological environment in the good life of the people is increasingly prominent. The high - quality ecological environment is closely linked to the happiness of the people, and the people's attention to the ecological environment is getting higher and higher.

In March 2022, Xinhua News Agency jointly released "Big Data to see the attention and expectations of the National Two National Sessions in 2022". The ecological civilization ranked fourth, and the construction of ecological civilization was still a hotspot of the whole people.

Many scholars have also carried out the study of the relationship between the ecological environment and the happiness of the people. Xu Zhihua [3] analyzed the effects of air pollution and water pollution on happiness by matching provincial pollution data and personal happiness data. The article shows that the increase in Nitrogen dioxide concentration and increased waste water discharge volume will significantly reduce personal happiness. Zheng Junjun [4] and other analysis of models and empirical analysis can be concluded that with the improvement of material living conditions, people's environmental protection concepts gradually enhance, and more actively pay more attention to and advocate green lifestyle. In the future the level of people's livelihood will be closely related to the quality of the environment. George Mackerron [5] use smartphones to conduct a questionnaire survey on more than 20,000 British participants. The type of green or outdoor activities is happier than in the urban environment, and the beautiful natural environment has a positive impact on personal happiness.

2.2 Ecological Education Helps Improve Environmental Quality

People have conducted research on ecological governance from all angles, such as putting forward different paths for ecological governance from the aspects of management, sociology, economics, political science, and philosophy. To realize the harmony between man

and nature, it is not enough to rely on the efforts of experts and environmental protection departments and the improvement of policies and regulations. Ecological governance to concern everyone's interests requires the common participation of the general public. Extensive development of ecological education can effectively enhance people's ecological awareness, cultivate people's ecological consciousness, enhance people's ecological capabilities, and then effectively improve human ecological behavior. In the new era, in the face of new challenges, the new path of actively exploring ecological education is not only an effective way to solve ecological problems, but also a new issue facing ecological education.

The significance of ecological education is not just to increase the knowledge reserves of people's ecological environmental protection. The more important value of ecological education is to promote the change of human thinking concepts. The first is to change the value concept of human rule of nature in the past, and replace the values of harmony with nature and nature. Engels had warned, "Thus at every step we are reminded that we by no means rule over nature like a conqueror over a foreign people, like someone standing outside nature—but that we, with flesh, blood and brain, belong to nature, and exist in its midst" [6]. Ecological education makes people realize that the concept of conquered nature will eventually harm the interests of human beings and threatens human development, thereby transforming the binary concept of man and nature.

The second is to replace the world view of mechanical restoration theory that has been popular in modern times with overall ecological thinking. Through the study of ecological knowledge, people can scientifically understand the material and energy cycle of nature, deeply understand the whole and system of the ecosystem, and truly understand the importance of the balance between people and nature. Establish a scientific concept of "only one earth", man and nature are the community of destiny. The change of concept can effectively guide people to adhere to sustainable development consciously in life, practice green and environmentally friendly production, life, and consumption, and protect nature scientifically.

3 The Feasibility of the Metaverse Ecological Education

3.1 Theoretical Feasibility

The theoretical basis used in the field of ecological education is the development of Situated Cognition theory [7]. The Situated Cognition theory was formed in the mid-to-late 1980s and began to penetrate into the field of education in the 1990s. The Situated Cognition theory is that knowledge is born in the interaction between people and specific situations. "Knowledge is an activity, not a specific object; it is always based on the situation, not abstract; knowledge is constructed in the process of interaction with the environment, not objective decisions, nor subjective generated; Knowledge is a state of interaction rather than facts" [8]. Situation Cognitive theory emphasizes that situations are necessary conditions for learning and carried out. The situation has the function of clue guidance in students' learning activities, which helps students to retain the knowledge. In addition, the creation of the situation has achieved remarkable results in stimulating students' emotional experience and enhancing the effect of teaching.

The characteristics of the fusion of the metaverse can create the specific situation needed for ecological education under the support of technology. Metaverse created embodied social environment, based on block chain trust mechanism and high fidelity learning environment will effectively solve the problems of the learning space, such as learning environment distortion, centered on the student is difficult to realize, lack of learning immersion, and across time and space high-order thinking training, etc. [9] In the field of ecological education, specifically, traditional ecological education is limited by physical spaces such as school classrooms, which mainly depends on the instilling ecological knowledge, and emotional incentives are lacking. In addition, “environmental protection, ecological crisis and other behaviors have long feedback time and difficult to observe the results. It is difficult to link with the direct experience of the subject, and it is difficult to trigger an emotional learning mechanism” [10]. The high - fidelity learning environment created by the metaverse makes the content of ecological education more abundant and vivid, and the form of education is more diverse, which will stimulate the ecological emotions of learners. It can effectively make up for the defects of traditional ecological education. The metaverse is a new pattern, which is of great significance for improving the quality and efficiency of education and providing new motivation for the development of teaching and learning [2].

3.2 Reality Feasibility

Ecological education, as a powerful starting point for the construction of ecological civilization, has always been limited by the physical space such as school classroom, and mainly relies on the indoctrination of ecological knowledge. There are problems such as boring learning content and single form, which is not conducive to stimulating the ecological emotion of learners, and the effect of ecological education is not obvious. The outbreak of COVID-19 has shifted teaching from offline to online [11]. Many experts believe that this virtual universe has great potential in its application in education [12].

Some scholars have pointed out that with the help of embodied learning, the metaverse ecological education becomes easier to learn about environmental protection [13]. Due to the long - term and lagging of ecological consequences in real life, people often cannot feel the destruction of their own behavior on the ecological environment, and it is difficult to reverse the predicament of the ecological environmental protection. Education's immersive experience helps people intuitively feel the ecological consequences that cannot be experienced in real life. With the help of the physical environment implemented by the metaverse, the learning of the ecological environment has a positive role in stimulating the ecological emotions of learners, completely different from traditional knowledge - based ecological education, and has a positive impact on students' positive ecological behaviors. Education to create specific situations to stimulate ecological emotions through embodied learning, transform into specific ecological protection practice, and truly empower ecological education.

For example, the metaverse can be used to accelerate the degradation process of polyethylene plastic garbage in nature, so that people can intuitively feel the ecological consequences of plastic use and improper discarding, and greatly enhance people's emotional experience. The metaverse also can be used to realize the integration of ecological education and cultural tourism resources, and use the characteristics of the virtualization

of the metaverse to allow learners to appreciate the magnificent natural scenery such as mountains, flowing water, ocean, and jungle, and stimulates students' love of nature. The integration of ecological education and historical disciplines helps learners travel to ancient cultural sites and comprehensively understand the relationship between man and nature. The immersive virtualization experience implemented by the metaverse is different from the simplicity of the pure knowledge teaching in the past. The metaverse can create an immersive learning opportunity to improve students' motivation for learning [14]. On the basis of learning the evolution of the relationship between people and nature, so as to promote the conscious environmental protection behavior of learners in reality and help the realization of environmental protection goals. Various forms of active interactions that occur in the virtual learning situation of the metaverse can become active information cognitive activities. This is more effective than passive knowledge learning [15].

4 The Way to Carry Out the Metaverse Ecological Education

4.1 What Problems Should Metaverse Ecological Education Pay Attention to

As the theoretical and technological development of the metaverse is still in the initial stage, the research of the metaverse is not yet mature. The introduction of the metaverse into ecological education requires as much as possible to avoid the risks and challenges that the metaverse may bring.

First, avoid new digital monopolies. The development of the metaverse needs to rely on high intelligent technology. It is difficult for ordinary users to occupy a dominant position in the digital age. It is impossible to master a large number of resources such as information and technology. Thousands of ordinary people are dominated easily by a few technology and capital giants. In the metaverse ecological education, we need to be alert to the monopoly and manipulated by companies with strong capital and minorities.

Second, pay attention to protecting the privacy of learners. The metaverse is considered a new form of the next generation of mobile Internet. It requires a large amount of data in the establishment and development of user identity and social relations. The data privacy and information security issues involved will be more complicated. If data security and privacy protection will be ignored, it will bring the chaos of the order of the metaverse, which will affect the relationship between people in the real world. "In the metaverse, the existing personal information and personal data protection laws and ethical specifications are far from this new trend" [16]. Actively improve the legal norms of personal privacy protection and data security. Pay attention to the privacy and security of individual users in the metaverse.

Third, avoid addiction and protect the physical health of learners. At present, the use of the metaverse needs to use specific tools such as VR glasses and helmets. If you use these devices for a long time, learners will have different degrees of physiological discomfort to endanger personal health. Some studies have reported that many children in the United States have symptoms such as nausea, dizziness, lost direction or loss of space consciousness after using VR helmets [17]. Therefore, the application of the metaverse ecological education will definitely adhere to the principle of moderate, restrict the use

time of supporting equipment appropriately, and avoid the negative impact of the health of the metaverse ecological education on the health of the learner.

4.2 The Metaverse Ecological Education Should Adhere to a Few Basic Principles

First of all, metaverse ecological education should adhere to the principle of people-oriented and protecting reality. The educational metaverse should pay close attention to the actual needs of learners, and should not construct the educational content solely from the theory, and break away from the interests and needs of learners.

Secondly, the development of the metaverse virtual world should contribute to the realization of human happiness, and pay attention to the balance between virtual and reality. “The metaverse cannot replace the real world, but is a virtual digital space reflected by the real world, and cannot exist in isolation from the real world....It is the symbiosis, integration and co-creation with the real world” [18]. Although the metaverse has great potential in transforming human ecological education, it cannot completely replace the ecological education in reality. Metaverse ecological education is the extension of real ecological education, constantly enriching the content, way and form of ecological education. Exploring the new ecological education system of virtual and real integration is the direction of metaverse ecological education in the future, rather than replacing the reality with virtual. In essence, human beings always live in the real world, and the development goal of the metaverse should be to help human beings live better and happier in the real world.

Furthermore, metaverse ecological education itself needs to adhere to the principle of sustainable. “The metaverse has great dependence on virtual reality, data centers, data twins, etc., especially for network broadband, computing power, distributed storage, real-time touch interaction, cloud services, etc. The surge in power consumption needs to pay a large cost of environmental protection” [18]. The goal of the metaverse ecological education is to stimulate the ecological emotions of the learners, and then transform into positive ecological behaviors, and actively participate in the situation of improving the environment. If its own development is an activity that consumes resources, it will inevitably lose persuasion and is not conducive to the promotion in ecological education. Therefore, how to reduce the construction cost of the metaverse is also an important project that needs to be considered. The development of the metaverse cannot be separated from reality, and its construction must depend on reality resources. Therefore, it is necessary to consider environmental and resource constraints and adhere to the principle of green and sustainable development.

4.3 The Way to Promote the Metaverse Ecological Education

The realization of metaverse ecological education is a comprehensive project, which not only needs to pay attention to the digital literacy and ability of teachers, but also needs the efforts of the government, enterprises, schools and families, which is a systematic project.

The first is to improve the digital literacy and ability of teachers. The ecological education of the metaverse is different from traditional education. It can break through the time and space restrictions of the real world. It provides immersive learning through

digital twin technology and continuously enriches the content and form of teaching. For example, to play the role of the metaverse ecological education in simulation of real learning situations, teachers are required to have the basic ability to build and apply scenarios [19]. How to efficiently integrate information about teaching content, student needs, spatial layout, and situation design, build more realistic teaching space, and correctly create a highly realistic situation such as historical scenes and geographical environment. The primary problem, actively carrying out diverse teachers' digital training, and striving to improve the digital literacy and ability of teachers is the prerequisite for the smooth progress of metaverse ecological education.

Second, multiple efforts are made to promote the practice of metaverse ecological education. The realization of the metaverse does not solely rely on the development of a certain technology, but needs to collect a variety of intelligent technologies, which has high technical requirements. Metaverse ecological education cannot be conducted without the support of intelligent technologies such as big data, artificial intelligence, Internet of Things, 5G/6G network, and also needs wearable technology devices such as VR glasses and helmets. To carry out the metaverse ecological education, we must improve the supporting technology and equipment, which is inseparable from the support of the government, enterprises, schools, families and other parties. For example, the government should support the development of relevant technologies, constantly improve the laws and regulations in the field of metaverse, and improve the normative system. Enterprises should continue to carry out technological innovation, use a variety of incentive to encourage the research and development of the metaverse technology, and provide technical support for the practice of the metaverse ecological education. Schools need to actively create a digital learning environment, and so on.

5 Conclusion

The metaverse has broad application prospects in the field of ecological education. The immersive experience achieved by digital twin and other technologies has unique advantages in stimulating learners' ecological emotions, helping to enrich the content and form of traditional ecological education, and optimize the actual effects of ecological education. It is of great significance to ecological governance and ecological civilization construction. However, because the development of the metaverse technology is still in its infancy, it is necessary to pay attention to the problems of the metaverse ecological education in digital monopoly and privacy. Abstract. For the features of the Metaverse, such as permeation, interactivity, anytime, anywhere, low latency features, and so on. It enhances the traditional industries' evolution. In this paper, based on the previous studies of Intelligent Railway Passenger Station (IRPS), the technology architecture of the Metaverse in IRPS is proposed. The metaverse application in IRPS is designed to promote the intellectual development of IRPS in information space that extends the temporal and spatial scale of Intelligent Railway.

The Metaverse is a technology gathering that includes 5G communications, cloud computing, digital twins, artificial intelligence (AI), blockchain, and expanded reality

A virtual environment of the metaverse based on the actual physical world that incorporates real-world economic, social, and entertainment activities and allows for multi-user participation in its creation [4].

The Metaverse advances industrial automation [5]. BMW is building a virtual factory with Omniverse to pre-build digital models before building cars. Production efficiency by about 30% [2].

The combination of metaverse and education [6] can enhance physical practices in the schooling process, improve the efficiency of participatory activities, enhance daily sensory experiences, and provide technical support for the construction of virtual learning communities, gamification, and personalization of teaching and learning, contributing to revolutionary changes in education.

Metaverse is exploring applications in the medical field [7], emerging in several aspects of medical prevention, diagnosis, treatment, and medical education. The health metaverse is one of the innovative solutions to address the global healthcare challenges that usher in a profound digital transformation of the worldwide healthcare system.

During the COVID-19 pandemic, the metaverse will promote the development of film and animation, game experience and interaction, performing arts content and presentation effects, digital operation of large festivals and exhibitions, protection of cultural and tourism resources, intelligent tourism, and other aspects.

The potential application scenarios of a metaverse in the construction field [2]. The Enhanced IRPS realizes the convenient travel of passengers [10], Seamless self-service, an efficient organization of production, secure real-time

monitoring, green and eco-friendly, through building the fully interconnected physical station and fully mirrored digital twin station for physical-information mapping fusion, total sense simulation, real-time monitoring, precise diagnosis, deducing the state of a predicted physical entity in a real-world environment. The analytics platform layer of The Enhanced IRPS's overall architecture compose by the platforms of data aggregation and sharing, controlling and collaboration linkage, intelligent service, cloud computing, digital twins, internet of things, big data analysis, and other platforms.

The metaverse incorporates various new information technologies such as 5G communications, edge computing, digital twins, artificial intelligence, blockchain, and virtual/augmented reality [11]. The metaverse forms a virtual world in information space that is identical and independent of the real world [4]. The railway metaverse covers the entire society-physics- cyberspace of railway transport and makes rail transport transcends the limits of time and space, which advances the opening of the railway with additional socioeconomic advantages.

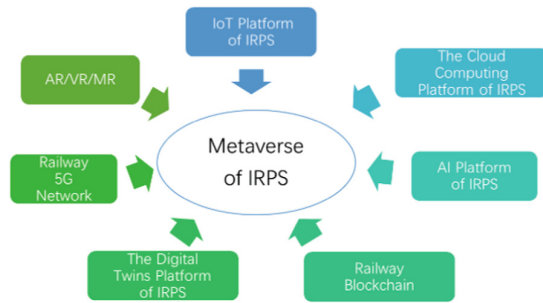


Fig. 1. The technology architecture for the metaverse of IRPS

The Railway blockchain supports the metaverse application in IRPS economic system, ensuring the safety of the virtual identity and assets of metaverse users and ensuring the legitimacy of transactions. The digital twins Platform of IRPS establishes a digital mirror of some railway station, realizes the full mirror of the real world to the virtual world, and provides a basis for the virtual primary metaverse, the virtual-real symbiosis, and the virtual-real linkage of the railway intelligent passenger station. The Railway 5G Network is a channel for the metaverse to provide low-latency, high-speed, and large-scale access, providing users with a more real-time and smooth experience. AR/VR/MR technology offers an immersive metaverse experience, allowing users such as travelers and staff to interact with virtual objects.

3 The Design of Metaverse Application in IRPS

Many digital twin stations have been preliminarily constructed in IRPS. 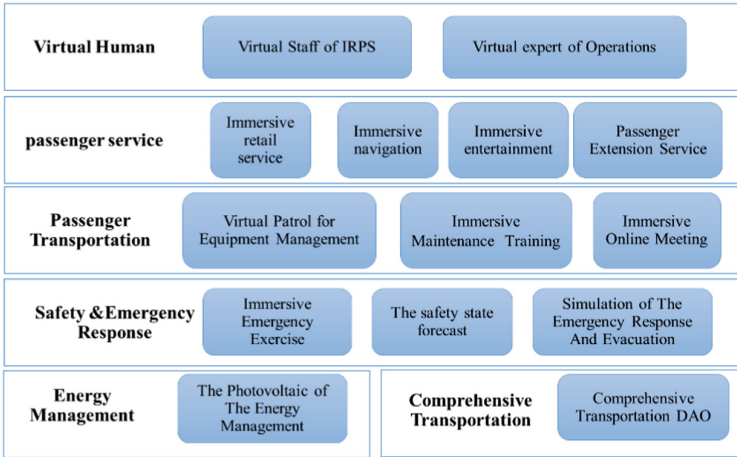


Fig. 2. The design of metaverse application in IRPS

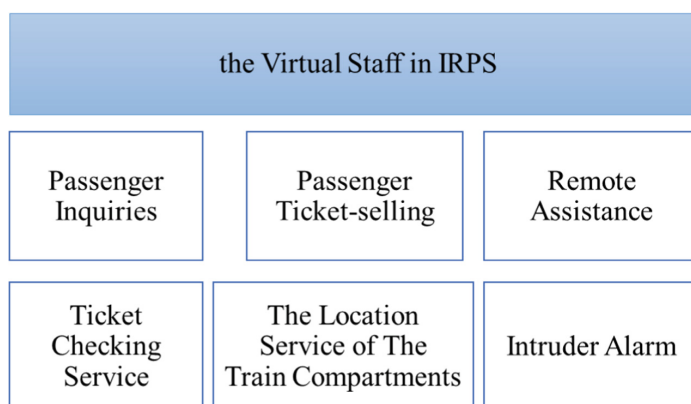


Fig. 3. The virtual staff in IRPS

When passengers encounter problems at the station, the virtual staff in IRPS can provide remote assistance. To ensure safety, the virtual staff in IRPS also offer services on the platform, such as the location service of the train compartments and intruder alarms. The Virtual Staff in IRPS can also provide uninterrupted 24 h of service, with high stability, concurrency, and work efficiency. With the development of a front-projected holographic display, the service for locating train compartments may be replaced by this one to make the sign clearer and more prominent (Fig. 3).

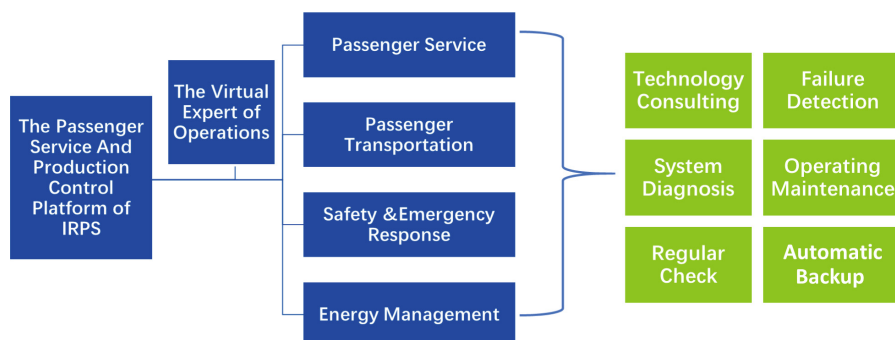


Fig. 4. The virtual expert of operations in IRPS

Virtual Expert. The Virtual Expert of Operations in IRPS provide service that includes technology consulting, system diagnosis, regular check, failure detection, operating maintenance, automatic backup, and so on. The Passenger Service and Production Control Platform is the core of IRPS. For the knowledge base management system, the Virtual Expert of Operations provides 24-h uninterrupted maintenance services for platform users (Fig. 4).

3.2 Passenger Service

The Passenger Service in IRPS provides Immersive navigation so that users can faster grasp the environment information, such as retail store service desk, restroom, and ticket barrier. Virtual Retail offers a new channel for buying specialty products without physically entering a store while waiting. Immersive entertainment provides interactive e-books, immersive movies and animations for children in the Baby Care Room station. Passenger extension services include cloud tourism, digital collections of railway

stations, railway cultural and creative products, station sandbox games, management games, and online station exhibition galleries.

3.3 Passenger Transportation

The Passenger Transportation in IRPS consists of virtual patrol for equipment management, multi-professional joint inspection, remote control and operation and maintenance of equipment and facilities, immersive training, and online meetings. Virtual patrol for equipment management offers a new channel for inspection equipment without physically walking through the station and provides multi-disciplinary maintenance and remote control of the equipment. Immersive training places staff in an interactive learning virtual environment to teach particular skills such as train scheduling and fire-fighting. Immersive online meetings offer a cyberspace room for anyone anywhere, such as a station, train, or bureau. Participants can get their facial expressions during the conference through the avatar as if they were communicating face-to-face.

3.4 Safety &Emergency Response

The Safety &Emergency Response in IRPS consists of an immersive emergency exercise, the state prediction of security, and simulation of the emergency response and evacuation. Immersive emergency exercise offers a new way for participants to practice their skills by handling a pre-created virtual disaster such as widespread delays, fires, floods, earthquakes, or some other disasters. The participants are able to rescue passengers in the disaster after completing each step as planned. The safety state forecast shows the dynamic outcome of changes in rail transport. Immersive emergency response and evacuation simulation can improve emergency response capabilities at passenger stations.

3.5 Energy Management

By retrofitting existing station canopies and roofs to allow for photovoltaic power generation. Use blockchain technology to record proof of electricity generation and consumption. We are enabling the management of the entire lifecycle of the station's photovoltaic power resources based on multi-party consensus and tamper-evident nature. Promote carbon neutrality at railway stations. Issuance of a station passenger carbon neutral token exchange service, which rewards different amounts of tokens depending on the amount of electricity consumed, to be exchanged for more welcoming station train services.

3.6 Comprehensive Transportation Hub

As the value of digital assets continues to emerge, railway passenger stations, as data generators and holders, rely on their strengths to form station data industry ecologies. It can create a Decentralized Autonomous Organization (DAO) together with subway, air, bus, and taxi. We research the user portrait within the organization to provide accurate and personalized services.

4 Conclusions and Future Works

Based on the previous studies of Intelligent Railway Passenger Station (IRPS), we analyze the commonalities between the metaverse technology and the development direction of IRPS, and the technology architecture of the metaverse in IRPS is proposed. And we designed the metaverse application in IRPS, including virtual humans, passenger service, passenger transportation, safety & emergency response, energy management, comprehensive transportation hub, and so on. in information space to extend the temporal and spatial scale of Intelligent Railway, the metaverse technology promote the intelligent development of IRPS. But the research of the Metaverse technology is just getting started, especially in the security protection of information. We will focus on it in the follow-up study.

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
