

ABSTRACT

Abstract: *The Bandung City Health Office building, given by the state to serve public health administration, is strategically located after several moves. The building is an important asset for education and preservation of the regional locality, especially Sundanese, in line with the West Java Provincial Regulation that emphasizes traditional values. As a busy agency, employee productivity and room ambience greatly affect performance. Although the building underwent refurbishment to maintain functionality and visuals, interior design that does not take into account the well-being of the occupants can be an obstacle. Architectural identity that reflects symbols of locality is an option that supports the sustainability of locality values or characteristics of a region, in accordance with regional regulations. However, the results of the comparative study analysis show several obstacles in air circulation, lighting, and room layout that are not yet optimal. Therefore, it needs to be balanced with adequate facilities and pre-facilities, introducing what locality is in the Sundanese area, and still paying attention to user comfort and not disturbing activities in the office building.*
