

ABSTRACT

The Education Unit Operational Assistance Program (BOSP) in Indonesia aims to ensure equitable and quality access to education through the provision of non-personal operational funds for basic education units. In an effort to increase transparency and accountability in the management of BOSP funds, the DKI Jakarta Provincial Government introduced the Education Accountability Information System (SIAP BOSP) application which is regulated by Governor Regulation Number 120 of 2020. This application was developed by PT Tabel Data Informatika in collaboration with Bank DKI and schools in DKI Jakarta Province, and is designed to facilitate school financial management. The development of this application involves a process of analysis, development, and testing. As a result, the SIAP BOSP application was successfully implemented, providing an effective solution in improving the accountability and transparency of financial management. However, this application still requires further maintenance and development so that the system can run more optimally.
