Insights gathered from interviews with stakeholders such as Disperdagin officials, Klinik Kemasan staff, web UI designers, and IKM partners emphasize the importance of this digital platform in overcoming operational challenges such as geographical barriers and limited access to information. This proposed page features comprehensive service descriptions, online application forms, and educational materials with a responsive design that can be accessed across devices. This initiative not only improves the service delivery process but also strengthens the competitiveness of SME products in local and international markets. It is hoped that the Packaging Clinic page can become an important resource in supporting the growth and development of small and medium industries in Bandung Regency.
