***Abstract :** Early childhood education is an early education for children that is carried out by playing methods. The early childhood education learning method that supports children to learn while playing is the center learning method or commonly referred to as Beyond Centers and Circle Time (BCCT). This method applies 6 aspects of center learning such as preparation centers, natural materials, role play, imtaq, blocks, and art. The diversity of existing learning aspects makes it necessary to have facilities and infrastructure that support this method in meeting the needs of children to do learning activities while playing. TKIT AN NAHL as a center-based PAUD school, still does not have interior infrastructure facilities that support children's activities and behavior in learning while playing. So, a new design of the school is carried out using a child behavior approach to provide interior facilities that are able to support the center learning method and are able to provide more complete facilities with a wider capacity. The child behavior approach is carried out by making observations related to the stages of children's learning that are carried out while playing accompanied by daily behavior in children. Through the child behavior approach, it is expected that this design is able to support children's learning methods by providing facilities that support children's growth and development and help build children's character and social skills.*
