

ABSTRACT

In the digital era, digital literacy is the key to building a smart and cultured generation. Bandung Regency, with an HDI of 82.09 points by 2022, has shown its commitment to improving literacy. However, the limitations of traditional publication media and underutilisation of digital platforms have prevented information on Dispusip's programmes and activities from reaching the public.

To address these issues, the Bandung District Dispusip in collaboration with Telkom University's Smart City FIT CoE developed the web-based Kampung Bedas Literat (KABELAT) Application. KABELAT aims to increase interest in reading and digital literacy, overcoming obstacles to the publication of news activities & announcements, and supporting literacy efforts in a structured and comprehensive manner through registration & login features and managing population data.

The development of KABELAT is expected to improve the digital literacy of the people of Bandung Regency, make literacy programmes more structured and effective, and strengthen Bandung Regency's commitment to building a smart and cultured generation in the digital era.
