

ABSTRACT

This scientific report discusses the interior design of a home office in Summarecon Bandung and the interior design of a library at SMKN 9 Bandung. The purpose of designing the interior of the home office in Summarecon is to serve as a residence for the client and a functional stopover or discussion space with aesthetic value. Meanwhile, the goal of the interior design of the library at SMKN 9 Bandung is to refresh the library's appearance to enhance productivity and creativity for both students and teachers who use it. The scientific report in this design is conducted using qualitative research methods with the process of primary and secondary data collection. Primary data sources were obtained from direct documentation in the form of field surveys, while secondary data sources were obtained from literature reviews through ergonomic standards in the book Human Dimension Centre. There is also a design process that follows the company's SOP in the interior design of the home office in Summarecon and the library at SMKN 9 Bandung, involving the company's staff and the Principal of HarAa Studio, contractors such as Artakara Studio and CG Studio, as well as the clients who are the owners of the design. After the design was completed, the result was the constructed home office design in Summarecon, which met and supported the client's needs and requests to serve as a residence and office for the volunteer team, providing a comfortable and safe atmosphere for users. Additionally, the interior design of the library at SMKN 9 Bandung was also completed as one of the school support facilities, designed to meet the needs of teachers and students to access information sources and discuss comfortably and safely for its users.
