INTERIOR REDESIGN OF THE SUKABUMI CITY BAPPEDA OFFICE

The preparation of development plans at the city level is carried out by the Regional Development Planning Agency (Bappeda). Development elements include social, economic and political, as well as adjustments to environmental conservation to encourage sustainable development. Sustainable development is supported by the establishment of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) by the UN to achieve sustainable development at the global level. The Indonesian government has made SDGs one of its national development priorities, with the issuance of Presidential Regulation (Perpres) Number 59 of 2017. Until now, regional governments have implemented SDGs independently based on their capacity. One of them is the Sukabumi City Government. However, based on the Scorecard for achieving indicators on District/City SDG Readiness in West Java Province, Sukabumi City faces several challenges to achieve SDGs in 2030. Strengthening institutional foundations that are appropriately functional and collaborative as well as improving the quality of ASN contribute greatly as a driver for achieving other SDGs indicators. In this case, the productivity of government employees and good office layout need to be improved. Based on field observations, several problems were found in the interior area which hampered the comfort and activities of employees. Therefore, it is necessary to redesign the interior of the Sukabumi City Bappeda Office using an activity approach.
