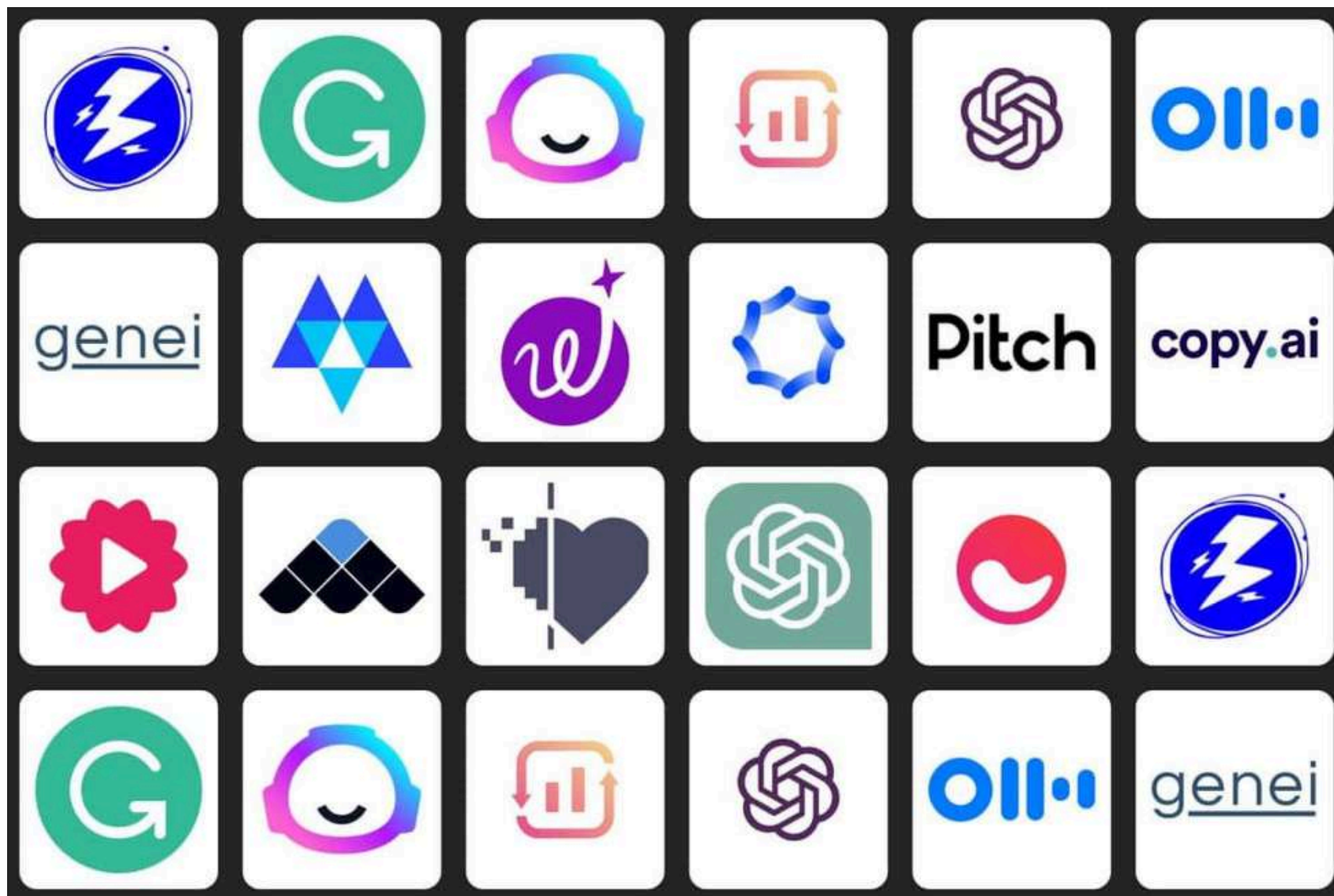

INTRODUCTION



Artificial Intelligence (AI) is a branch of computer science focused on creating systems that can perform tasks that typically require human intelligence.

These tasks include reasoning, learning, problem-solving, perception, language processing, and decision-making.

Type of AI For Researchers

GENERATIVE AI

Refers to a type of artificial intelligence that **can create new content, data, or solutions by learning patterns and structures from existing information.**

Key Features of Generative AI:

- **Creation of New Content**
Generative AI can create new data or content that resembles the data it was trained on.
- **Learning from Patterns:**
vast amounts of data to understand the underlying patterns, structures, or features.

TASK-SPECIFIC AI

Also known as **narrow AI** or **weak AI**, refers to artificial intelligence systems that are **designed and trained to perform a specific task or solve a particular problem.**

Key Characteristics of Task-Specific AI:

- **Focus on One Task:**
Task-specific AI is highly specialized in solving one problem or performing one function.
- **High Efficiency in the Target Task:**
Because it is optimized for a specific task, task-specific AI typically performs that task with high efficiency, accuracy, and speed.

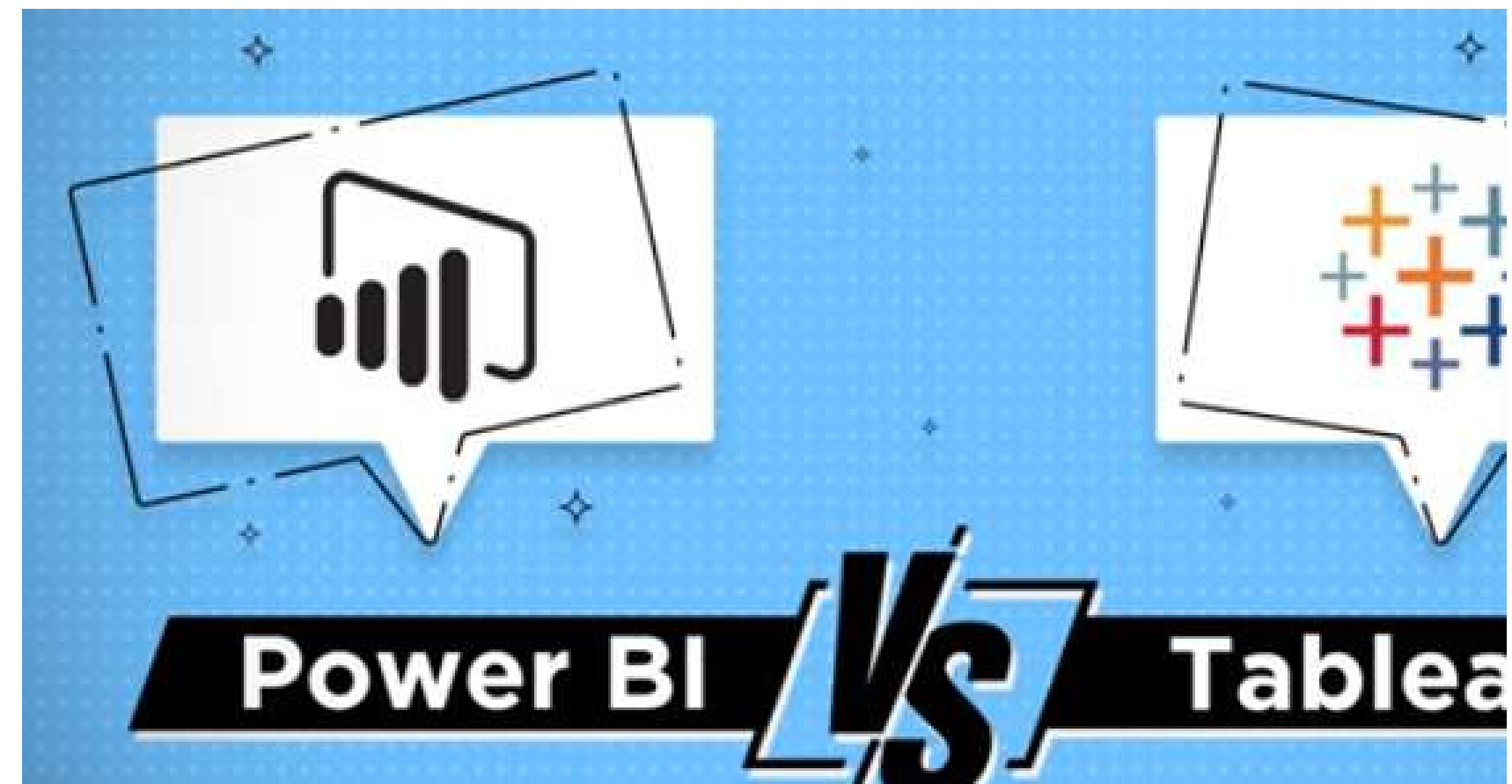

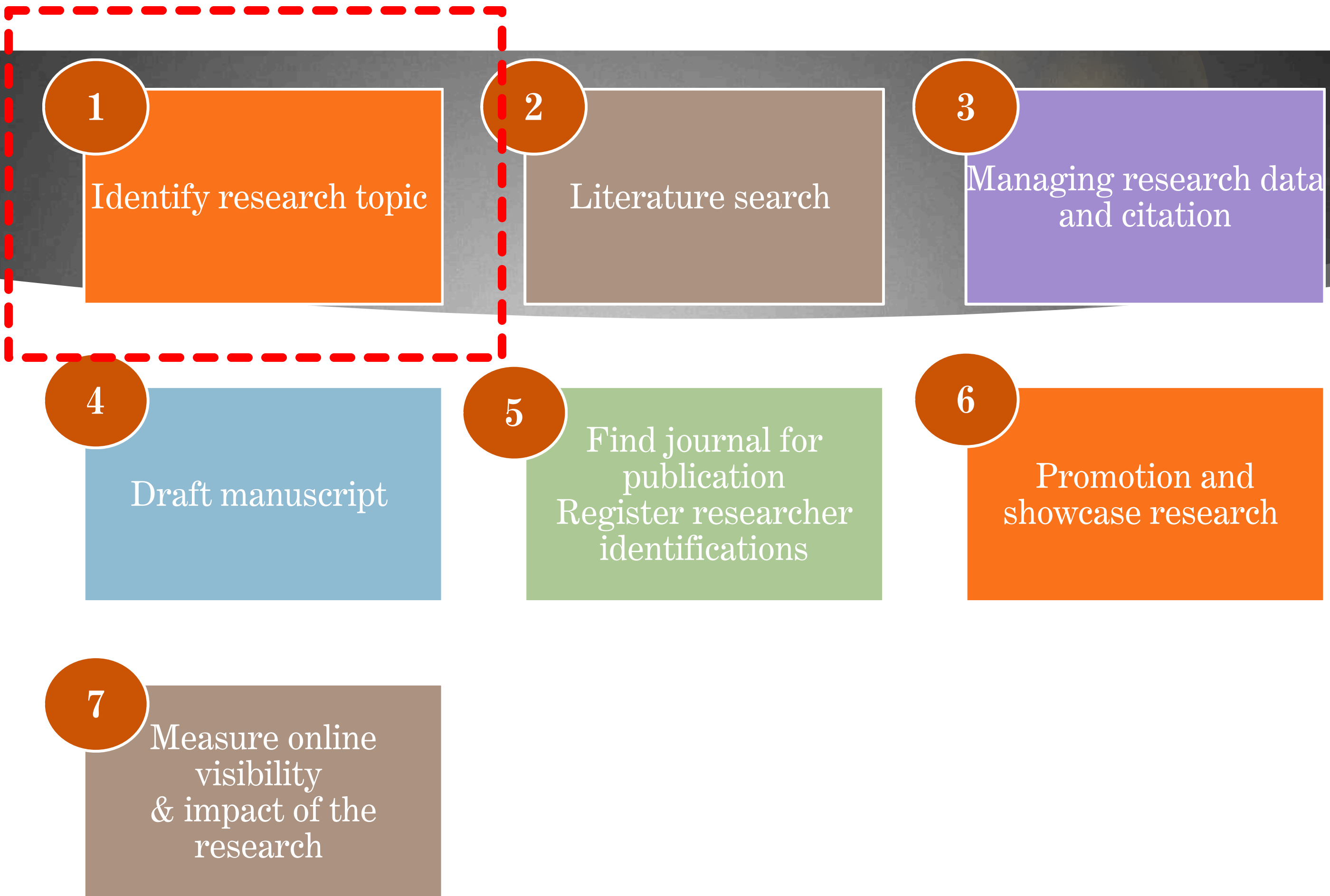

IDENTIFY RESEARCH TOPIC : Use Natural Language Processing (NLP)

AI Tools:

GPT-based tools, Semantic Scholar, or connected platforms like Iris.ai.



Approach:

Input general areas of interest, and NLP tools can summarize recent papers, highlight trending research questions, and identify gaps in existing studies.

They can **help in generating summaries, topic modeling, and even keyword analysis to find specific focus areas.**

Example

Input keywords like “work performance” or “employee productivity” **to find papers and summaries, then analyze common themes and under-researched topics.**

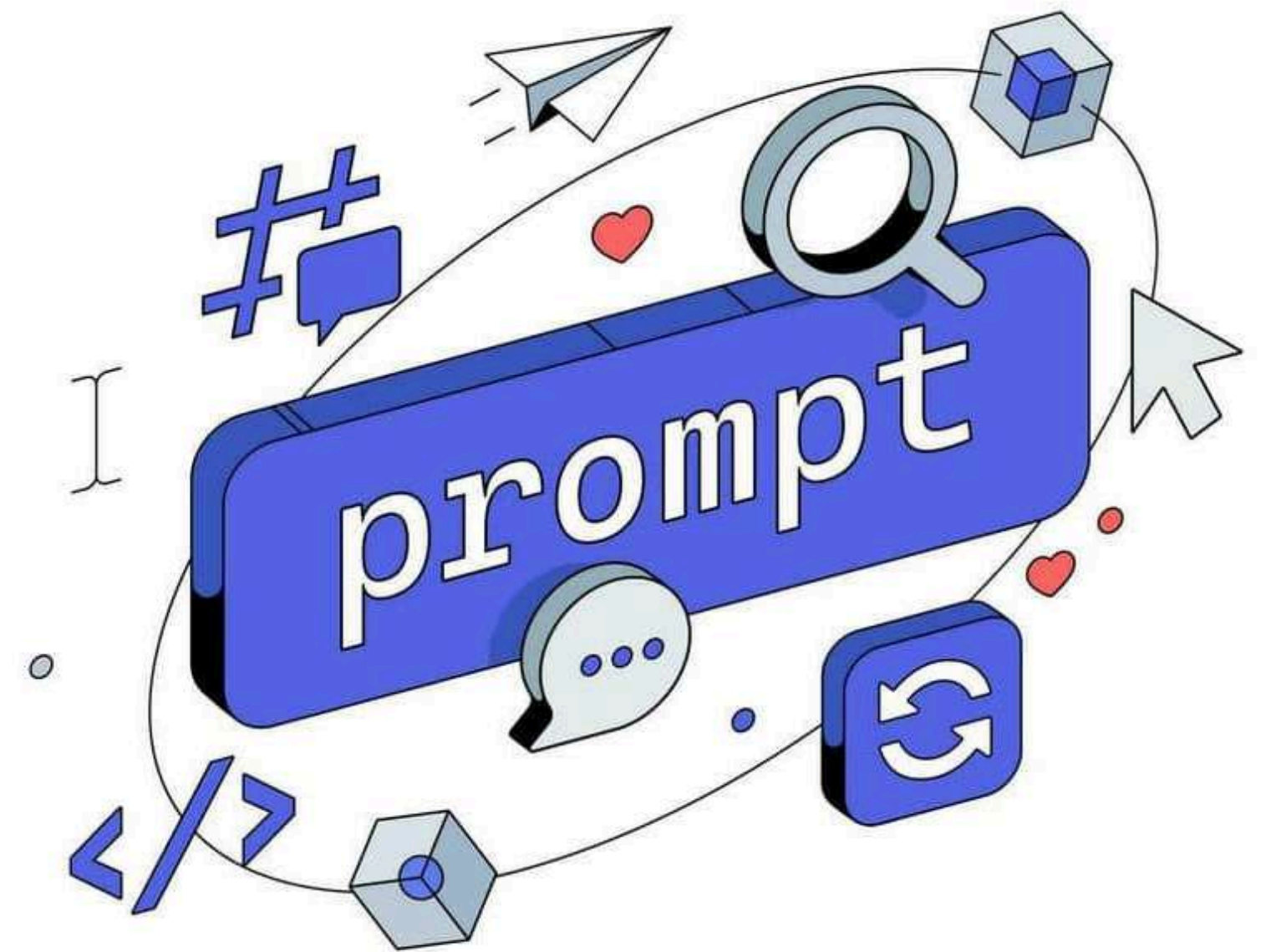

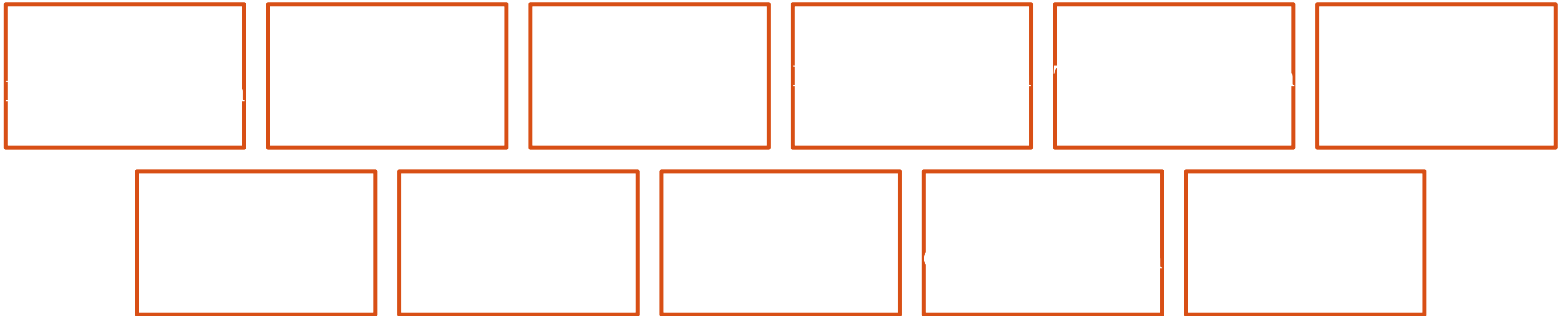

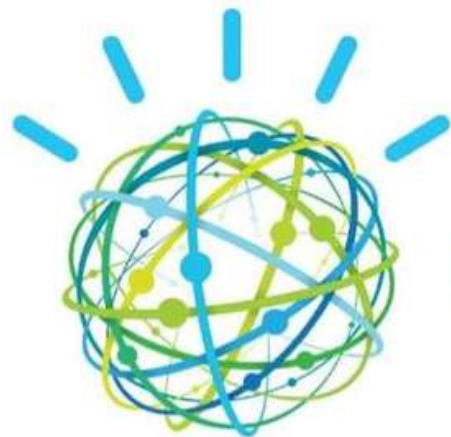

Approach:

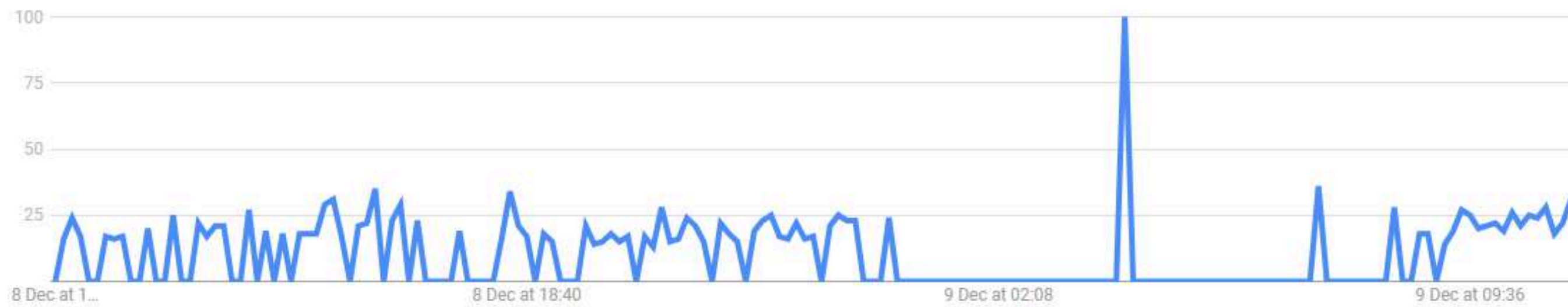

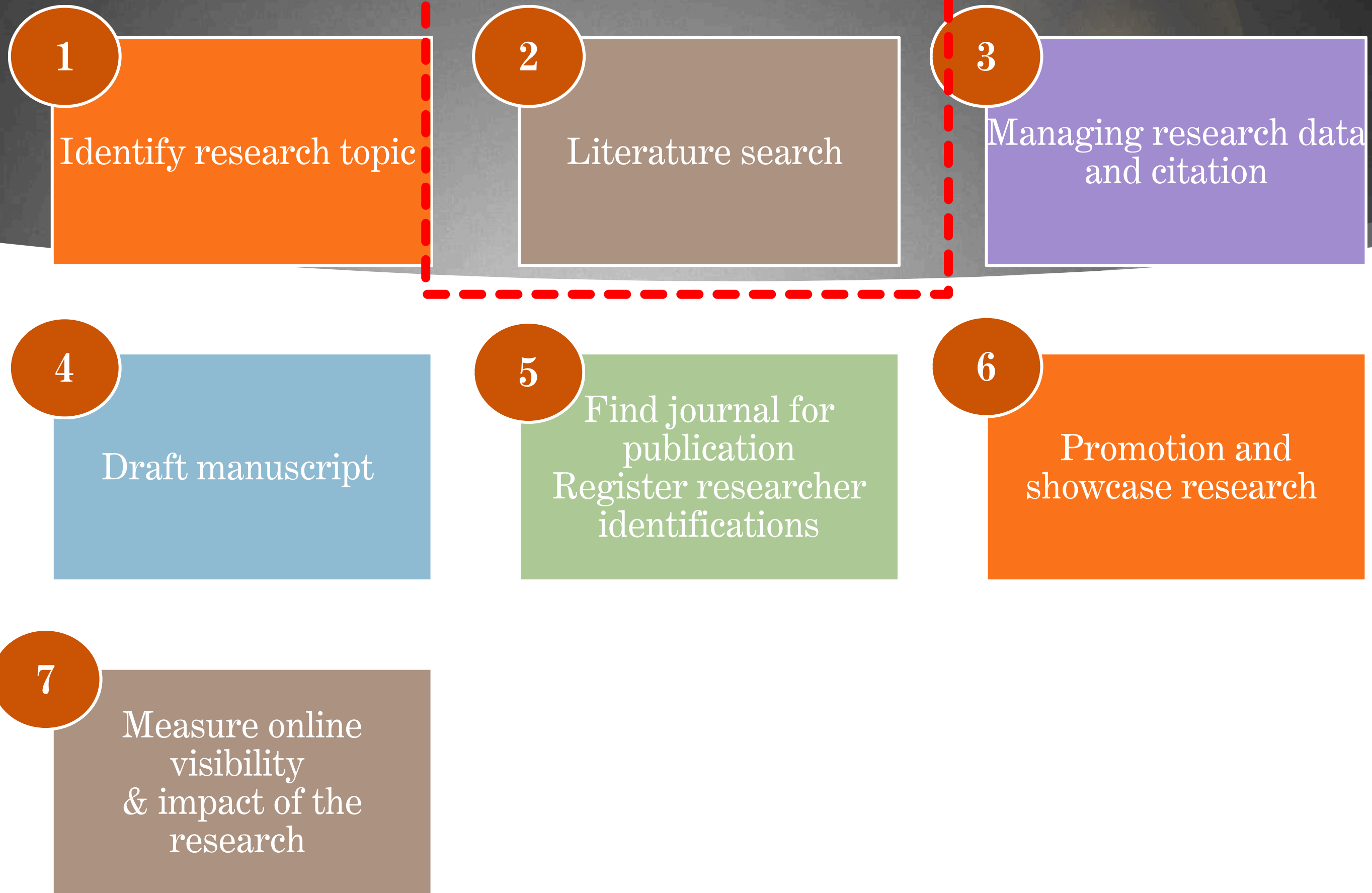

Approach

These platforms use AI to **enhance search relevance and provide recommendations based on citations, influential papers, and keywords.**

How to Use

Start with keywords or phrases relevant to your topic, like "hydrogen energy in clean technology," and use filters for publication date, field, or citation count to refine your search.

Semantic Scholar, for example, highlights key phrases and citation chains, helping identify seminal papers quickly.

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Work performance in Malaysia is influenced by a multitude of factors, including workplace environment, ergonomics, employee satisfaction, and the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic. The interplay of these elements shapes the overall productivity and efficiency of Malaysian employees across various sectors.

One significant factor affecting work performance is the workplace environment. A study highlighted that a crowded and hostile workplace is significantly associated with burnout among healthcare workers in Malaysia, suggesting that workplace conditions can directly impact employee well-being and productivity (Shaharul et al., 2023). 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The Goliath of the Sea

The majestic blue whale, the goliath of the sea, certainly stands alone within the animal kingdom for its adaptations beyond its massive size. At 30 meters (98 ft) in length and 190 tons (210 short tons) or more in weight, it is the largest existing animal and the heaviest that has ever existed. Despite their incomparable mass, aggressive hunting in the 1900s seeking whale oil drove them to the brink of extinction; there are other reasons for why they are now so endangered.



The blue whale's common name derives from bluish-white while its Latin designation is *Balaenoptera musculus*, a suborder of cetaceans, also known as baleen whales, a fingernail-like material, called baleen, attached to the upper jaw, used exclusively on krill, though they also take small numbers up to 40 million krill in a day.

These gargantuan beasts used to dominate all the oceans of the century, when the technology was developed to effectively hunt them. Norwegian Svend Foyn equipped a steamboat with harpoon lines to hunt large whales. This led to the killing of hundreds of thousands of whales. The International Whaling Commission banned the practice in 1966.

The blue whale certainly appears grand in size and beauty, but its communication is also sublime. Amazingly, their vocalizations have a frequency range of 10 to 40Hz. Though they typically communicate with Humpback whales do, some subspecies have been observed to communicate with four notes. Blue whale calls are still not fully understood, and scientists are currently working on determining their purposes. Among the hypotheses, researchers believe the calls could serve to determine one's geographic location, identify individuals, or locate prey.
