

ABSTRACT

Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises (UMKM) play an important role in Indonesia's economy, but many of them face challenges in operational management, one of which is the payroll process. Laqisya Café, established in August 2024, is a UMKM operating in the Food and Beverage sector, located in Bandung Regency, West Java. The payroll process at Laqisya Café is still done manually by the owner, involving salary calculations based on attendance, bonuses, leave, and deductions, as well as employee data management. The main problems that arise are the time-consuming manual bookkeeping and susceptibility to errors, as well as inefficient data storage risks. Therefore, a web-based payroll application is needed that can manage employee data, attendance, COA (Chart of Accounts), payroll calculations, payroll journals, payroll ledgers, and payroll reports. The development of this application uses the prototype method, aiming to simplify and speed up the payroll process and reduce the possibility of calculation errors, while increasing productivity. This application is expected to help Laqisya Café manage payroll data more effectively and efficiently.
