ABSTRACT

The Bandung Diocesan Office is an administrative and pastoral center located on Jalan

Moh. Ramdan, Bandung City. With an area of 12,000 square meters and lodging facilities

for clerical guests and out-of-town communities, the office not only performs administrative

functions but also serves as a space for cross-community activities. However, a number of

problems were identified, including some spaces have different intensity of use such as the

Bishop's room and meeting rooms, no supporting spaces such as first aid and lactation rooms

and the need to adjust the configuration and atmosphere of the space and activities for the

children's faith atrium.

The redesign of this office aims to create a healthier, more efficient, and inclusive

workspace and cross-community space with a design approach that integrates the spiritual

value of the Diocese of Bandung, namely "Silih Asih" which is in line with the values and

teachings of Catholicism. This concept is expected to present a space that is not only

functional, but also reflects the spirit of love, service, and openness to all visitors. By paying

attention to the physical, emotional, and spiritual needs of users. Both in terms of visitors

and office employees.
