

ABSTRACT

Vanz Apparel is one of the Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) in Bandung Regency engaged in the convection sector, especially in the sale of plain t-shirts by implementing the sales method, namely make to order, but the transaction process and order recording are still done manually often causing data discrepancies, recording errors, and difficulties in preparing financial reports. The payment system used is a down payment (DP) for sales based on orders. The main objective of developing this application is to manage sales transactions based on orders, producing general journals, ledgers, and sales reports. The method used in developing this application is the Software Development Life Cycle (SDLC) with the Waterfall model, which includes the stages of analysis, system design, coding, and testing. This application was tested using Blackbox and developed using application tools, Visual Studio Code, XAMPP, and the Laravel Framework. This application is expected to address manual record-keeping issues, streamline sales management based on orders, and enable more precise and structured financial reporting.
